THE 30TH ANNUAL LETTER CARRIER'S STAMP OUT HUNGER FOOD DRIVE SET FOR MAY 14TH

Odessa, TX – May 09, 2022 – The West Texas Food Bank is once again participating in the National Association of Letter Carrier's (NALC) Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive.

Midland and Odessa residents are encouraged to fill up a sturdy bag with nonperishable and unexpired foods to be left out by their mailbox on May 14th.

This is the 30th year for this event.

"This is always one of the largest food drives that happens in the Permian Basin," said Libby Campbell, CEO of the West Texas Food Bank. "We are so grateful to the Letter Carriers who work really hard to make this a success, and I am always blown away by the support of our community for our neighbors in need."

The West Texas Food Bank is still serving almost double the amount of families since the beginning of the pandemic. In our last fiscal year we distributed almost thirteen million pounds of food. We are able to distribute these large amounts of food through a network of partner agencies and support of our very generous community.

In the 30 years since it began, the food drive has collected about 1.82 billion pounds of food for struggling residents, nationally. According to NALC Stamp Out Hunger Coordinator, Sallie Moore, the food drive relies on its local and rural letter carriers to carry out the event.

Please remember to place a sturdy bag of nonperishable food by your mailbox on Saturday May 14th. Your letter carrier will return the food to the post office where it will be donated to the West Texas
