Ascertainment Methodology

Our station employs an active listenership. As a result, ascertaining the issues and topics for local public service programming comes in several forms:

1) Emails:

The Program Director, News Director and all On-Air Talent are easily accessible via the internet. Our Station's Web Page provides listeners with the opportunity to send us information.

2) Voice Mail & In Studio Calls:

The Program Director, News Director and On –Air Talent regularly receive phone calls from listeners regarding community concerns, issues and events. Public Service Organizations also contact us with information they need to get out to Hampton Roads residents or activities they would like us to promote.

3) Faxes:

Typically, organizations send press releases via fax to the News Director or Program Director. Local city government officials most often communicate what they would like aired in this fashion. Public Service groups do the same. The Station uses faxed information for local live PSA's, local public service vignettes and the locally produced 30 minute public service programs.

4) Mail:

Some listeners/groups send the station a letter to let us know their concerns, to inform us about activities or ask us to cover certain topics.

5) Station Appearances:

Since our listenership is so active, we are fortunate to have our station events well attended. Station personnel are always on-hand and ready to listen. Many listeners take the time to tell us what they think about our programming and what they would like us to consider airing.

These are locally produced Public Service programs on that air on this station. Each provide 30 minutes of public service programming each week.

Both shows are approximately : 30 minutes in length

The show topics are ascertained from non-profit organizations in the Hampton Roads region who send in Public Service Announcements; news and events in the community.

“ 60 Seconds/Crime of the Week ”

Locally Produced Public Service Segments

Airs on WGH FM, WGH AM, WVHT FM, WVBW FM, WVSP FM

Produced by Jim Long, News Director, Producer/Host of 'Topics ' and Mark Rawlison Producer/Host of 'Inside Hampton Roads' of Max Media, VA

These segments are called Hampton Roads Crime of the Week or Sixty Seconds. They are Recorded Public Service Announcements from Max Media of Virginia that air on each station.

For Southside and Peninsula crime activities, a Detective or the PIO serve as the liason/spokesperson. For the Sixty Seconds segment the information can be provided by a local agency *such as* the American Red Cross or VA Department of Health. The Flight of each segment varies as it depends on the flow of information from area police departments, or timeliness of a topic, ie. Being Safe while You Enjoy Swimming and Water Safety from the American Red Cross. For Hampton Roads Crime of the Week the officer comes to the studio to voice a segment that informs the public of various crimes that need to be solved. Listener's are asked to call into the anonymous tip line, 1-888-Lock -U- UP with information. If that information leads to an arrest a cash reward is given.

Each is 60 seconds in length
