## **I. AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE**

### **News on Daybreak – July 15, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:59**

Beth Hunt reported a Little Rock engineering firm is moving across the river. Garver engineers broke ground Tuesday on a new ten-million dollar corporate headquarters in North Little Rock. The company has been in Little Rock since 1919 but said they ran out of room to expand their current headquarters on Battery Street. Governor Mike Beebe thanked the company for staying in Arkansas and says the expansion will benefit the entire area. The company says they will hire 120 new employees to staff the expansion.

### **News on Live at 5 – August 11, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:59**

Jessica Dean reported that farmers for pilgrim's pride have also received some devastating news. 140 conway county farmers received notice today that their services would no longer be needed. This is absolutely devastating... in fact farmers i spoke with today told me this is the worst thing that has ever happened to the conway county chicken. Pilgrim's Pride notified the farmers about the situation with a letter which says the company would no longer need the farmers chickens due to a "difficult operating environment in the US." One farmer estimates 90-percent of the 143 affected farmers still owe money on their buildings and many just don't know what they are going to do now. The average chicken farm brings in an estimated 150-thousand dollars a year. Coming up at six, hear from one farmer who has been raising chickens for 30 years and is now out of a job. ### **News on Daybreak – September 3, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:28**

Beth Hunt reported the fight is on against the invasive Northern Snakehead fish which has been found in East Arkansas. State and Federal wildlife agencies are planning to use a toxin to try to get rid of the fish. The chemical will be used in nearly 200 miles of waterways in Lee and Monroe Counties. The state banned the fish in 2002 but officials say earlier attempts to breed the fish in ponds resulted in the current population. The fish can travel on land, and is believed to have escaped from a pond.

## **II. CONSUMER AND LABOR**

### **News on Nightside at 10pm – July 27, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:34**

Christina Munoz reported sales are down in Little Rock according to a new federal report. The reports shows declining sales in consumer spending for the second quarter of the year. 40 percent of car dealers say sales are down from this time last year while half of the general retailers said the same. In real estate, the report shows a continued weakness in the residential housing market. But there is good news for the services sector it showed some growth this quarter.

### **News on Nightside at 10 pm– August 21, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:24**

Christina Munoz reported that new jobs are on the way to Batesville. Announced today the company will spend two and a half million dollars to expand the factory that used to be home to GDX automotive and will need to hire a hundred new employees. The new facility will serve as a

distribution center for orders placed through the tractor supply company. Bad Boy makes five versions of mowers that are distributed in six different countries.

**News on Daybreak – September 17, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:26**

Beth Hunt reported more than 30 subpoenas have been sent out from the attorney general's office to gas stations across the state. The move comes in the wake of thousands of reports of price gouging after Ike hit the oil-rich gulf coast region. The stations will have 20 days to respond to the subpoenas. If enough evidence is found McDaniel says he will demand the businesses make restitution and pay penalties. Around 52 stations in all are included in the subpoenas.

### **III. CRIME AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE**

Christina Munoz reported a homicide investigation in Pine Bluff after a truck runs off the road. When police got to the vehicle, they found 23 year old Jessten Collins unresponsive inside. The coroner pronounced him dead at the scene from a possible gunshot wound to his left side but the exact cause of death will not be known until after he is examined at the state crime lab. Police identified 20 year old Terry Calloway of Pine Bluff as a person of interest in the case and are looking for him tonight. **News on Nightside at 10:00pm – August 22, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:37**

Christina Munoz reported a bizarre and tragic story that ends with an infant dead and his father arrested. It happened in Cleveland County. Authorities say they were called to a home where six-month-old Mark Yenor III was not breathing, and relatives were trying to give him CPR. The child was pronounced dead at a hospital. Then deputies discovered that the infant's father 20-year-old Mark Yenor Jr. had been watching him before bringing him to a relative's house unresponsive. While the family tried to save the child the father allegedly broke into a nearby house and stole a gun. Mark Yenor Jr. is now facing manslaughter, burglary and theft charges.

**News at 6pm – September 17, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:32**

Scott Inman reported that a trial began today for the first of three brothers charged with capitol murder. They are accused in the death of 6 year old Kamya Weathersby from last December. Prosecutors began presenting the state's case against 18 year old Kevin Banks this afternoon in Pulaski County 2nd Division Circuit court after a jury was selected this morning. Earlier this week a judge granted a request to try the suspects separately with Banks to be tried first. 20 year old Ricky Smith's trial will begin on November 24th and 21 year old Marqus Smith will be tried on January 12th.

### **IV. DEFENSE AND VETERAN AFFAIRS (Secretary of State)**

**News on Saturday at 6pm – July 21, 2008**

**Duration: 00:00:48**

Pamela Smith reported a music festival in North Little Rock today benefits the Arkansas Fallen Firefighters Memorial. The hook and ladder country music charity event featured eight bands including Collin Raye and Diamond Rio. The 16 foot high Arkansas Fallen Firefighters Memorial will be placed on the west side of the state capitol. The memorial will include a wall listing the names of the state's firefighters who died in the line of duty. **News on Daybreak – August 7, 2008****Duration: 00:00:50**

Beth Hunt reported a 34 page report released by the VA Office of Inspector General finds major problems with human studies at the VA Hospital in Little Rock. Investigators found researchers did not follow protocol when it came to reporting serious adverse events and conducted HIV testing on several patients without their consent and that documents were destroyed before a federal audit. UAMS Chancellor Dodd Wilson, whose school's institutional review board oversaw the studies says they were "low risk" and issues raised by the audit have been addressed. A spokesperson for the local VA Hospital system says officials plan to make a comment about the report today. To read entire report log on to k-a-t-v-dot-com.

Christina Munoz reported the Central Arkansas Veterans Healthcare System is setting up a triage center for hurricane evacuees. It will be located at Little Rock's Central Flying Service. The center is third on the list to receive patients from the gulf coast. Less than two weeks ago the same center was set up for Gustav, and they accepted more than 200 patients. Little Rock Air Force Base is also providing some support for hurricane Ike, flying patients away from coastal areas, and organizing medical personnel teams.

## **V. EDUCATION AND YOUTH**

**News on Nightside at 10 pm – July 23, 2008****Duration: 00:00:35**

Christina Munoz reported Pulaski Tech's Aviation Center will soon double in size and student body thanks to a one-million dollar grant. Senator Blanche Lincoln announced the grant from the US Department of Commerce and Economic Development this afternoon calling it an investment in Arkansas's growing aerospace industry and an investment in human capital. The new facility should be complete by sometime next year.

**News on Daybreak – August 21, 2008****Duration: 00:00:26**

Beth Hunt reported that more than 650 hard hats were handed out at Mount Saint Mary Academy instead of pencils and paper. The white plastic shells were given to students and faculty yesterday to help kick off a new school year and new construction. Renderings and floor plans for a 7-point-7 million dollar renovation and expansion were revealed in an announcement at the school. So far more than 5-million dollars has been raised through donations and grants to complete the project.

**News on Daybreak – September 18, 2008****Duration: 00:00:26**

Anne Pressly reported three children in Pulaski County are missing this morning. Kerston Ratcliff, Cortnee Ratcliff and Tyler Yarberry haven't been seen since Tuesday. Authorities believe the three could be with 28-year-old William Blundell. Authorities also suspect the three are in a red Mitsubishi Eclipse with Arkansas plates 589MNB. ### **News on Nightside at 10 pm – July 28, 2008**

Pamela Smith reported on a program held today in Jacksonville to help cut down ground level ozone. Ground level ozone is the main ingredient in smog and it can be caused from the fumes that escape from gas cans. The new gas cans, distributed at the Jacksonville Recycling Center today, help prevent those fumes and gas from spilling out. We are replacing old gas cans with new gas cans that are environmentally friendly ones primarily with the new gas cans these gas cans have a spring loaded delivery system which will not dispense until you actually get the nozzle into the lawnmower. A grant from the Environmental Protection Agency paid for the new gas cans.

Christina Munoz reported the Arkansas Food Bank has received some much need help in the form of peanut butter. 36 thousand jars of peanut butter were delivered to the food bank courtesy of Skippy Peanut Butter. Nearly 385 thousand Arkansans depend on nutrition assisted programs such as the food bank to be able to purchase the food they need for their families. Close to 80 percent of assistance goes to families with children. More than 53 percent of Arkansas' children in public schools rely on school nutrition programs and when school is out they are not getting it, they are not getting it. Which means there is a heavier burden placed on food banks across the state, and that is why this donation is so important. The donation is enough peanut butter to make over a half-a-million sandwiches.

Christina Munoz reported some medical patients forced to evacuate their home states because of hurricanes Gustav and Ike are returning home. As many as 40 ambulances along with a convoy of military vehicles arrived in Arkansas today to begin returning the patients to both Texas and Louisiana. Some of the vehicles came from as far away as Nebraska to help return the patients back home.

Michelle Rupp reported a study out today shows conflicting amounts of how much money a lottery would generate for education. The Lieutenant Governor is gathering signatures for voters to make the decision in November. Lieutenant Governor Bill Halter estimates more than 100 million dollars in scholarship money would be provided. There is passionate debate over a lottery in Arkansas. According to Wednesday's study, top lottery sales in Missouri, Oklahoma, and Texas happen on the Arkansas border. Lt. Governor Halter says every dime from the lottery will go to education for Arkansas students not those in bordering states. Arkansas advocates for children and families have a different viewpoint. Jessica Dean reported that friends are gathering at the state capitol to honor and remember Bill Gwatney. There are new developments in the case today. We now know more information about the gunman, 50 year old Timothy Dale Johnson. Funeral arrangements have been made for

Gwatney, and flags will be lowered to half staff on Monday. Governor Beebe spoke publicly for the first time since his death. The vigil is just getting started you can see dozens of people have shown up to honor the late Bill Gwatney. A mix of people came here tonight, everyone from public officials to ordinary citizens. Organizers tell us this short vigil will be a time of prayer, reflection, and remembrance. Reverend Steve Copley will lead the crowd in prayer while Lawrence Hamilton will sing a song in honor of the democratic chairman. We will have full coverage of this vigil coming up on Nightside.

Beth Hunt reported big endorsements are in both for and against a lottery proposal in Arkansas. Former University of Arkansas Chancellor John White threw his support in favor of the lottery efforts. Meanwhile, the Family Council Action Committee got a 75-thousand dollar check from Jim Walton toward a campaign opposing a state-run lottery. We're just pleased that he understands the lottery and knows how bad it is for Arkansas and we're glad he's helping us. I believe the beneficiaries of this scholarship program will be the young people and their parents but also those institutions that will now see young people come to them to pursue a degree who otherwise would not have. Voters will decide whether to approve a state constitutional amendment creating a lottery to fund the hope scholarship.

**The following phase-in schedule applies to the captioning and broadcast of all new programming. It is measured on a calendar-quarter basis and a 20-hour broadcast day, as programming between 2am and 6am does not have to be captioned.**

- Between January 1, 2000, and December 31, 2001, program distributors must provide at least 450 hours of captioned programming per calendar quarter, which is approximately five hours per day. If the program distributor provides less than 450 hours of new programming, then 95 percent of its new programming must be captioned.
- Between January 1, 2002, and December 31, 2003, program distributors must provide at least 900 hours of captioned video programming per calendar quarter, or 10 hours per day. If the programming distributor provides less than 900 hours of new programming, then 95 percent of its new programming must be captioned.
- Between January 1, 2004, and December 31, 2005, program distributors must provide at least an average of 1,350 hours of captioned video programming per calendar quarter, or 15 hours per day. If the program distributor provides less than 1,350 hours of new programming, then 95 percent of its new programming must be captioned.
- **As of January 1, 2006, and thereafter, 100 percent of the program distributors' new programming must be captioned.**
