

PEOPLE AGAINST RAPE...HELPING PREVENT SEXUAL ASSAULTS

AIR DATE: APRIL 15, 2018

GUEST: SHELBY WADE...PREVENTION AND EDUCATION COORDINATOR WITH THE LOCAL ORGANIZATION PEOPLE AGAINST RAPE.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ORGANIZATION'S WORK...AND A NEW METHOD IT IS USING TO TRY AND STOP RISKY SITUATIONS BEFORE THEY START.

CHARLESTON'S VIBRANT BAR SCENE MIXES VISITORS...A
DOWNTOWN COLLEGE POPULATION....AND LOCALS. PEOPLE
AGAINST RAPE HAS STARTED A NEW CAMPAIGN IN THOSE
BARS...ASKING BARTENDERS TO TRY AND KEEP TRACK OF WHAT'S
HAPPENING. IT IS ALSO POSTING CARDS IN BAR RESTROOMS THAT
INCLUDE THE ORGANIZATION'S PHONE NUMBERS FOR THOSE WHO
MAY HAVE EXPERIENCED AN ABUSE OR AN ATTACK.

THIS IS BEING DONE IN THE RECOVERY ROOM BAR ON UPPER KING STREET. THE PROGRAM WAS TESTED THERE AND WITH POSITIVE RESULTS...AND HAS SINCE BEEN EXPANDED TO OTHER BARS.

WADE NOTES THAT SADLY...MANY SEXUAL ASSAULTS GO UNREPORTED. SHE SAYS THERE IS STILL A STRONG STIGMA WHEN IT COMES TO CALLING POLICE AND GOING THRU THE INVESTIGATIVE PROCESS. IT MEANS TOO MANY OFFENDERS ARE NEVER PROSECUTED

THE NORTH CHARLESTON ARTS FESTIVAL MAY 2-6, 2018

AIR DATE: APRIL 22, 2018

GUESTS: KYLE LAHM...DIRECTOR OF THE NORTH CHARLESTON ARTS AND CULTURE DEPT...AND ANN SIMMONS...DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE ARTS DEPT.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE UPCOMING FESTIVAL IN NORTH CHARLESTON. THE FESTIVAL IS CLOSE TO 40 YEARS OLD...WHICH IS ALMOST AS OLD AS THE CITY ITSELF.

THE ANNUAL FESTIVAL ATTRACTS 35 TO 40 THOUSAND VISITORS. LAHM AND SIMMONS SAYS THIS YEAR WILL BE NO DIFFERENT THAN PAST FESTIVALS....LOTS OF PERFORMANCES...ART EXHIBITS...PHOTOGRAPH DISPLAYS....AND OTHER EXAMPLES OF ART. MOST OF THE FESTIVAL IS FREE TO SEE...BUT SOME PERFORMANCES WILL BE TICKETED EVENTS.

THE FESTIVAL ALWAYS INCREASES NORTH CHARLESTON'S PROFILE IN THE SOUTHEASTERN REGION...AS WELL AS NATIONALLY. THERE HAS EVEN BEEN INTERNATIONAL INTEREST IN THIS ANNUAL EVENT.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CLASSES BERNIQUE OFFERS THOSE WHO WANT TO DO MORE WITH THEIR MONEY...THAN SIMPLY SPEND IT. THESE CLASSES ARE FREE....OR LOW FEE SESSIONS....FOR THOSE WHO (NO MATTER HOW MUCH THEY MAKE) WANT TO BETTER MANAGE THE MONEY THEY HAVE.

THE MISUSE OF CREDIT CONTINUES TO BE A MAJOR PROBLEM FOR THOSE TRYING TO MANAGE FUNDS BETTER. IN AMERICA TODAY...WE SEE SOMETHING...AND WE BUY IT...USING CREDIT CARDS. THE PAIN COMES LATER WHEN THE BILL COMES DUE. BERNIQUE SAYS CONTROLLING CREDIT IS THE FASTEST WAY TO MORE INDEPENDENCE.

THIS INTERVIEW CAME ON THE HEELS OF FEDERAL AND STATE INCOME TAX TIME. NO ONE LIKES WRITING THAT CHECK TO THE IRS OR THE STATE. BETTER PLANNING...INVESTING AND SAVING WILL MAKE FUTURE TAX DEADLINE DAYS EASIER TO HANDLE.

BUILDING MORE HABITAT FOR HUMANITY HOMES FOR VETERANS

<u>AIR DATE:</u> MAY 6, 2018

GUESTS: LYNN BOWLEY...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF CHARLESTON HABITAT FOR HUMANITY....AND KRISTEN WILLIAMS...DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT WITH HABITAT FOR HUMANITY.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON A NEW QUEST FOR THE HABITAT ORGANIZATION...AND THAT IS PUTTING MORE VETERANS IN HABITAT HOMES.

THERE IS A SIZEABLE NUMBER OF HOMELESS MILITARY VETERANS IN THE CHARLESTON AREA. HABITAT WANTS TO HONOR THEM WITH HOMES....BUT FOR SOME REASON THE GUESTS SAY IT HAS BEEN DIFFICULT TO GET VETS TO GET INVOLVED.

HABITAT STRESSES THAT THESE ARE NOT FREE HOMES.
APPLICANTS HAVE TO MEET STRICT REQUIREMENTS AND MUST PUT IN AT LEAST 600 HOURS OF SWEAT EQUITY WITH HABITAT. HOMES COME WITH A LOW COST MORTGAGE.

BOWLEY AND WILLIAMS SAY PTSD AND OTHER PROBLEMS
SUFFERED BY SOME VETS MAY BE CONTRIBUTING TO THEM NOT
BEING INTERESTED IN A HABITAT HOME. EFFORTS WILL CONTINUE.

THE TASTE OF GULLAH AND THE SWEETGRASS FESTIVAL

AIR DATE: MAY 13, 2018

GUEST: THOMASINA STOKES MARSHAL....FORMER MT PLEASANT TOWN COUNCILMEMBER AND THE FOUNDER OF THE TASTE OF GULLAH AND SWEETGRASS FESTIVALS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THESE POPULAR UPCOMING EVENTS. THE TASTE OF GULLAH HAPPENS MAY 26^{TH}AND THE SWEETGRASS FESTIVAL HAPPENS JUNE 2^{ND} . BOTH ARE EDUCATIONAL AND FUN EVENTS.

THE FUN COMES WITH GULLAH FOODS...STORYTELLING...AND OTHER TRADITIONS.

THE EDUCATION IS MEANT TO INFORM ABOUT THE GULLAH GEECHEE CULTURE WHICH IS HUNDREDS OF YEARS OLD.

THE TASTE OF GULLAH CARRIES A 50 DOLLAR TICKET PRICE...AND THE MONEY GOES TO HELP FUND THE SWEETGRASS FESTIVAL AND CLASSES ON THE MAKING OF SWEETGRASS BASKETS. THERE IS A FEAR THE ORNATE BASKETS ARE ADMIRED...BUT THEY ARE MORE THAN THAT. STOKES-MARSHAL SAYS THERE IS AN ENTIRE HISTORY BEHIND THEM...AND SHE SAYS THAT MUST BE REMEMBERED AND APPRECIATED AS WELL.

BOTH EVENTS HAVE BEEN GROWING IN POPULARITY FOR THE PAST 13 YEARS...AND WILL CONTINUE.

THE GIRL SCOUTS OF EASTERN SOUTH CAROLINA...EVOLVING TO BETTER SERVE YOUNG GIRLS

AIR DATE: MAY 20, 2018

<u>GUESTS:</u> DONNA LEE....DIRECTOR OF COMMUNICATIONS AND MARKETING FOR THE GIRL SCOUTS OF EASTERN SOUTH CAROLINA AND REPUBLICAN HOUSE DISTRICT 99 REPRESENTATIVE NANCY MACE

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE NEW DIRECTION OF THE LOCAL GIRL SCOUTS COUNCIL.

THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA RECENTLY ANNOUNCED IT IS NOW ACCEPTING GIRLS TO BE PART OF THE BOY SCOUTS. SPEAKING FOR THE GIRL SCOUTS...LEE SAID THE BOY SCOUTS HAVE BEEN LOSING MEMBERS....SO ADMITTING GIRLS INTO THE ORGANIZATION WAS ITS WAY OF 'STAYING ALIVE'.

THE LOCAL GIRL SCOUTS ORGANIZATION SAYS IT IS STRIVING TO BE A BETTER PLACE FOR GIRLS AND YOUNG WOMAN BY OFFERING MORE ACTIVITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR GIRLS TO GROW INTO THE YOUNG LEADERS OF TOMORROW.

REPRESENTATIVE NANCY MACE IS HELPING IN THIS NEW DIRECTION BY SPEAKING TO THE SCOUTS ABOUT PUBLIC POLICY AND LEADERSHIP MATTERS.

MACE SAID SHE LEARNED THESE TRAITS THRU HER YEARS AS A GIRL SCOUT...AND DURING HER YEARS AT THE CITADEL. SHE BECAME THE FIRST WOMAN TO GRADUATE WITH HONORS FROM THE LEGENDARY MILITARY SCHOOL.

BEST FRIENDS OF LOWCOUNTRY TRANSIT...DEMANDING MORE MASS TRANSIT OPTIONS

AIRDATE: MAY 27, 2018

<u>GUEST:</u> WILLIAM HAMILTON....CHARLESTON LAWYER AND ONE OF THOSE INVOLVED IN THE TRANSIT EFFORT

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON HOW BEST FRIENDS OF LOW COUNTRY TRANSIT IS TRYING TO GET MORE BUSES RUNNING IN THE LOW COUNTRY.

HAMILTON SAYS THE EFFORT BEGAN IN EARNEST 7 YEARS AGO. IT WAS NOTICED THAT MT PLEASANT DID NOT HAVE ENOUGH CARTA BUS SESRVICE. HAMILTON...WHO IS LEGALLY BLIND...CONSIDERED THE PLIGHT OF OTHERS IN LOW INCOME CATEGORIES WHO ALSO NEED A RELIABLE MASS TRANSIT SYSTEM TO GET TO WORK. SO HE STARTED SPREADING THE WORD THAT MASS TRANSIT IN THE LOW COUNTRY COULD BE A LOT BETTER THAN IT WAS.

OTHER BUS ADVOCATES HAVE JOINED HIM OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS....ALSO DEMANDING CARTA DO MORE TO INCREASE BUS SERVICE IN MT PLEASANT...NORTH CHARLESTON...WEST ASHLEY...AND EVEN IN TINY LINCOLNVILLE.

EFFORTS TO GET A FOLLY BEACH BUS ROUTE HAS REPORTEDLY FAILED FOR THIS SUMMER. ITS SOMETHING BEST FRIENDS OF LOW COUNTRY TRANSIT CONTENDS CARTA JUST DOES NOT WANT TO DO.

THE SPECIAL WORK UNDERWAY AT MUSC AND THE HOLLINGS CANCER CENTER

AIR DATE: JUNE 3, 2018

<u>GUEST:</u> ELLEN SMITH....A MEMBER OF THE MUSC BRAIN TUMOR TEAM AND THE 2018 UNIT NURSE OF THE YEAR

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK AND RESEARCH HAPPENING AT MUSC AND THE HOLLINGS CENTER WHEN IT COMES TO BRAIN TUMORS.

SMITH SAYS THAT WHILE BRAIN TUMORS ARE NOT A COMMON PROBLEM...THE HOLLINGS CANCER CENTER SEES PATIENTS FROM ALL OVER THE STATE AND THE SOUTHEASTERN REGION.

LAST MONTH THE **HEAD FOR A CURE** 5K RUN AND WALK TOOK PLACE. IT WAS THE 3RD ANNUAL EVENT TO RAISE FUNDS AND AWARENESS OF BRAIN TUMORS. AND WHILE IT DOES NOT SOUND LIKE A 'SEXY' CAUSE TO SUPPORT....THE WALK AND RUN ATTRACTS A LARGER THAN EXPECTED CROWD EVERY YEAR.

THE DISCUSSION ALSO CENTERED ON THE WORK OF SPECIALIZED NURSES LIKE SMITH. THERE ARE MORE SUCH NURSES IN THE FIELD...AS RESEARCH GETS MORE SPECIALIZED.

NURSES ARE ALSO ON THE FRONTLINES....SOMETIMES MORE THAN THE DOCTOR. A PATIENT IS LIKELY TO SEE A NURSE BEFORE SEEING A DOCTOR.

SMITH SAYS NO ONE SHOULD GO INTO NURSING FOR THE MONEY. THE PROFESSION DEMANDS A CERTAIN RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN NURSES AND PATIENTS. SHE SAYS IT CANNOT BE FAKED.

NURSES WILL ALSO CONTINUE TO BE IN DEMAND AS BOOMERS GROW OLDER.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CLASSES BERNIQUE OFFERS THOSE WHO WANT TO DO MORE WITH THEIR MONEY THAN SIMPLY SPEND IT. THESE CLASSES ARE FREE OR LOW FEE FOR THOSE WHO WANT TO MAKE BETTER MONEY DECISIONS.

THE MISUSE OF CREDIT CONTINUES TO BE A MAJOR PROBLEM FOR THOSE TRYING TO BETTER MANAGE THEIR MONEY. IN AMERICA TODAY...WE SEE SOMETHING...WE BUY IT...AND WE ARE LIKELY TO USE PLASTIC TO DO IT. GUEST: TROY STROTHER....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF FATHER-TO-FATHER INC....AN ORGANIZATION THAT HELPS DADS GET REUNITED WITH THEIR KIDS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THIS 20 YEAR OLD ORGANIZATION THAT WORKS TO HELP FATHERS ESTABLISH RELATIONSHIPS WITH THEIR KIDS. DADS BECOME ESTRANGED FROM THEIR KIDS DUE TO BAD RELATIONSHIPS WITH 'THE MOTHER'...JAIL...FALLING BEHIND ON CHILD SUPPORT...LACK OF EMPLOYMENT...AND THE LIST GOES ON.

FATHER-TO-FATHER HELPS TO MENTOR MEN WHO'VE FATHERED KIDS...TO BECOME BETTER DADS. STROTHER SAYS TOO MANY MEN ON THIS...FATHER'S DAY WEEKEND...ARE SUFFERING BECAUSE THEY ARE KEPT AWAY FROM THEIR KIDS

THE EX WIVES AND GIRLFRIENDS OFTEN TIMES DO NOT HELP THE SITUATION FOR A VARIETY OF REASONS...NAMELY CHILD SUPPORT EITHER LATE OR NOT BEING PAID.

THE ORGANIZATION WORKS TO HELP FATHERS GET ON A BETTER TRACK...BY HELPING THEM WITH SKILLS TO GET JOBS...PAYING CHILD SUPPORT...AND STAYING OUT OF JAIL.

TRAFFIC IN THE LOW COUNTRY MAY BE BAD......BUT SEVERAL ORGANIZATIONS ARE DEMANDING WE FIX FLOODING FIRST

<u>AIR DATE:</u> JUNE 24, 2018

<u>GUEST:</u> BETSY LAFORCE....COMMUNITIES AND TRANSPORTATION PROJECT MANAGER WITH THE COASTAL CONSERVATION LEAGUE IN CHARLESTON.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE MOST RECENT STUDIES AND THE CONTINUING PROBLEMS WITH FLOODING IN CHARLESTON COUNTY. DESPITE TRAFFIC BEING THE NUMBER ONE COMMUNITY 'HOT TOPIC'....LAFORCE SAYS THE DIRECTION MUST BE CHANGED TO GET THE PUBLIC TO REALIZE FLOODING NEEDS TO BE FIXED FIRST.

THE POST AND COURIER RECENTLY RAN AN ARTICLE....QUOTING STATS FROM THE UNION OF CONCERNED SCIENTISTS.....THAT IN FEWER THAN 30 YEARS.....SOME 8,000 HOMES AND BUSINESSES IN THE LOW COUNTRY WILL FACE ROUTINE FLOODING...DUE TO RAINS AND INCREASED KING TIDES....AND EVEN FROM SEA LEVEL RISE.

TWO ZIP CODE IN PARTICULAR.....29455 ON JOHNS ISLAND....AND 29928 IN BEAUFORT COUNTY....WILL BE MOST AFFECTED BY THE INCREASED FLOODING. THESE AREAS COULD FACE AS MANY AS 28 FLOOD DAYS PER YEAR.

SO....HOW MIGHT WE COMBAT THIS....IF THE STUDIES ARE TRUE?

LAFORCE SAYS IT AND CLOSE TO A DOZEN ORGANIZATIONS WHICH INCLUDE SAVE SHEM CREEK AND THE HISTORIC CHARLESTON FOUNDATION ARE NOW ASKING THE CHARELSTON COUNTY COUNCIL TO SWITCH GEARS AND MAKE FLOODING FIXES THE TOP PRIORITY....INSTEAD OF THE BUILDING OF MORE ROADS.

IF ONE IS NOT AFFECTED BY FLOODING....IT IS PROBABLY NOT A TOP-OF-MIND CONCERN. LAFORCE SAYS FIX FLOODING FAST DOT ORG HAS ITS WORK CUT OUT IN EDUCATING THE PUBLIC ON PRIORITIES
