

GUESTS: DONNA LEE...DIRECTOR OF COMMUNICATIONS AND MARKETING FOR THE GIRL SCOUTS OF EASTERN SOUTH CAROLINA...AND REPUBLICAN NANCY MACE...STATE REPRESENTATIVE OF DISTRICT 99

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE NEW DIRECTION OF THE GIRL SCOUTS OF AMERICAN...AND THE LOCAL GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL. THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA ANNOUNCED LAST SPRING THAT IT WOULD BEGIN ACCEPTING GIRLS. LEE SAYS BSA HAS BEEN LOSING MEMBERS. IT'S BELIEVED THAT ADMITTING GIRLS WOULD BE A WAY FOR THE BOY SCOUTS TO 'STAY ALIVE'.

THE LOCAL GIRL SCOUTS ORGANIZATION SAYS IT IS STRIVING TO BE A BETTER PLACE FOR GIRLS AND YOUNG WOMEN BY OFFERING MORE ACTIVITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES...SO YOUNG WOMEN TODAY CAN BECOME THE YOUNG LEADERS OF TOMORROW.

STATE REPRESENTATIVE NANCY MACE IS HELPING THE LOCAL GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL IN TAKING THE SCOUTS IN ITS NEW DIRECTION. SHE IS EDUCATING YOUNG WOMEN ON THE ISSUES OF PUBLIC POLICY AND MATTERS OF LEADERSHIP.

MACE SAYS HER SCOUTING YEARS HELPED READY HER FOR HER YEARS AT THE CITADEL...HELPING HER BECOME THE FIRST WOMAN TO GRADUATE WITH HONORS FROM THE LEGENDARY MILITARY COLLEGE.

### THE ILLUMINATION PROJECT....MAKING PROGRESS THRU LISTENING SESSIONS

GUEST: REV KYLON MIDDLETON...OF THE MT ZION AME CHURCH DOWNTOWN CHARLESTON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON PROGRESS MADE BY THE ILLUMINATION PROJECT. THE PROJECT HAD BEEN FORMING IN THE YEARS LEADING UP TO TWO HIGH-PROFILE NEWS STORIES IN 2015. THE PROJECT WENT PUBLIC ON A LARGE SCALE FOLLOWING THE APRIL 2015 POLICE SHOOTING OF MOTORIST WALTER SCOTT IN NORTH CHARLESTON....AND THE JUNE 2015 SHOOTING DEATHS OF 9 PEOPLE AT THE MOTHER EMANUEL AME CHURCH DOWNTOWN.

THE PROJECT CONTINUES TO SEEK COMMON GROUND BY ESTABLISHING LISTENING SESSIONS BETWEEN POLICE AND MEMBERS OF MINORITY COMMUNITIES. THE SESSIONS ENABLE THESE SESSIONS....SO COMMUNITY MEMBERS CAN LISTEN TO POLICE CONCERNS....AND POLICE CAN LISTEN TO THE RESIDENTS THEY PROTECT.

THE PROJECT HAS A NEW LEADER. REV MIDDLETON PLANS TO CONTINUE TO WORK WITH POLICE AND OTHERS TO EXPOSE MORE COMMON GROUND THAN DIFFERENCES AMONG THE PARTICIPANTS.

THE EFFORT CONTINUES TO GAIN GOOD REVIEWS FROM THOSE WHO PARTICIPATE. AND THE LISTENING SESSIONS CONTINUE.

### THE CHARLESTON LITERACY ASSOCIATION...WORKING TO TEACH THE LOW COUNTRY TO READ

**AIR DATE: JULY 15, 2018** 

GUESTS: EILEEN CHEPENIK...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF CHARLESTON LITERACY ASSOC....KRISTIN WARRINGTON BROXTON...DOWNTOWN CHARLESTON SITE MANAGER...AND STELLA NECKER....ASSOCIATION'S PROGRAM DIRECTOR

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ASSOCIATION'S CONTINUING QUEST TO TEACH READING TO THOSE WHO HAVE NOT LEARNED THE VALUABLE LIFE SKILL. THOSE WHO DON'T KNOW HOW TO READ...OR READ RELATIVELY WELL...ARE SENTENCED TO A LIFE OF LOW INCOME AND POVERTY. MANY TIMES THE KIDS OF THOSE WHO CANNOT READ...PASS THE DEFICIT ALONG TO THEIR KIDS. THE THE CYCLE CONTINUES.

BUT THE LITERACY ASSOC TEACHES READING...HELPS DROPOUTS GET G-E-Ds....AND IN TURN...HELPS RESIDENTS GET JOBS.

WARRINGTON-BROXTON MANAGES THE DOWNTOWN SITE AND SAYS THERE ARE NEW PROGRAMS THAT PAIR MOMS WHO ARE LEARNING HOW TO READ WITH KIDS WHO ARE ALSO LEARNING. IT HAS PROVEN TO BE A VALUABLE PROGRAM.

NECKER SAYS THE LITERACY ASSOC ALSO TEACHES MATH SKILLS. SUCH SKILLS ARE NEEDED FOR MONEY MANAGEMENT AND BUDGETS.

#### THE AMERICAN RED CROSS IS ALWAYS READY FOR ANYTHING

AIR DATE: JULY 22, 2018

GUEST: CUTHBERT LANGLEY...SPOKESMAN FOR THE LOW COUNTRY AMERICAN RED CROSS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON ASPECTS OF WHAT THE RED CROSS DOES EVERY DAY. THAT IS....PREPARED FOR WHATEVER THE DAY BRINGS! IT'S A TALL ORDER...BUT THAT'S IT'S JOB. IF THERE IS A NATURAL DISASTER...THE RED CROSS GOES TO WORK. IF THERE IS A TRAIN OR PLANE ACCIDENT...THE RED CROSS IS THERE. IF A FAMILY EXPERIENCES A HOUSE FIRE...THE RED CROSS IS ON THE SCENE. AND WHEN BLOOD IS NEEDED AT ANY OF THE LOW COUNTRY HOSPITAL SYSTEMS....THE RED CROSS PROVIDES.

THE RED CROSS LOSES AN ESTIMATED 550 PINTS OF BLOOD DAILY IN THE SUMMER...DUE TO FEWER DONORS. SCHOOLS ARE OUT OF SESSION...RESIDENTS TAKE VACATIONS....AND FEWER BLOOD DRIVES ARE SCHEDULED. SOMEHOW...THE RED CROSS FINDS THE BLOOD NEEDED FOR THE LOW COUNTRY.

THE RED CROSS CONTINUES TO WORK WITH LOCAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND EVEN THE MILITARY TO INSTALL FIRE AND SMOKE DETECTORS IN HOMES THAT DO NOT HAVE THEM. THE ALARMS AND THEIR INSTALLATION ARE FREE.

THE RED CROSS CAN'T DO ANYTHING WITHOUT A HOST OF VOLUNTEERS. AND LANGLEY SAYS VOLUNTEERS ARE ALWAYS NEEDED.

#### FIXING THE CROSSTOWN....IN MEMORY OF ITS VICTIMS

<u>AIR DATE:</u> JULY 29, 2018

<u>GUEST:</u> LYNNETTE RANZ....A MOTHER WHO LOST HER DAUGHTER IN AN AUTO-PEDESTRIAN ACCIDENT ON THE CROSSTOWN JANUARY 2014

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CHANGES THE CITY OF CHARLESTON ANNOUNCED THIS WEEK ON THE SEPTIMA CLARK PARKWAY...OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE CROSSTOWN.

RANZ LOST HER 21 YEAR OLD DAUGHTER LINDSAY AS SHE WAS HIT BY A PICK UP TRUCK WHILE JOGGING AND CROSSING THE CROSSTOWN AT COMING STREET.

RANZ HAS BEEN THE 'LONE WARRIOR' IN THE BATTLE TO GET IMPROVEMENTS MADE TO THE HIGHWAY. OTHERS WHO HAVE LOST LOVED ONES ALONG THE ROADWAY HAVE NEVER JOINED HER IN HER BATTLE TO GET BETTER SIGNAGE....TRAFFIC LIGHT CONTROL....AND ENFORCED SPEED LIMITS.

WHILE RANZ SAYS THE CHANGES MADE ARE 'BETTER THAN NOTHING'...SHE SAYS MORE NEEDS TO BE DONE ON THE DEADLY HIGHWAY. SHE ALSO SAYS DRIVERS ALONG THE CROSSTOWN NEVER SEEM TO SLOW DOWN FOR PEDESTRIANS. SHE ALSO FINDS FAULT WITH AN OVER-THE-HIGHWAY WALKWAY THAT SHE SAYS NO ONE CAN FIND. RANZ SAYS IT NEEDS TO BE MORE ACCESSIBLE.

RANZ SAYS SHE WILL NOT STOP IN HER CRUSADE TO MAKE THE ROADWAY SAFER. SHE SAYS SHE WILL CONTINUE TO WORK WITH CITY AND STATE OFFICIALS. RANZ CONTENDS THE ROADWAY IS STILL DANGEROUS....AND WISHES GOVERNMENTS WERE MORE RECEPTIVE TO THOSE WORKING TO MAKE IT SAFER

### CHARLESTON WATERKEEPER....THE PUBLIC'S WATCHDOG ON THE LOCAL WATERWAYS

AIR DATE: AUGUST 5, 2018

<u>GUEST:</u> ANDREW WUNDERLY....EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF CHARLESTON WATERKEEPER

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THAT CHARLESTON WATERKEEPER IS ALL ABOUT. THE ORGANIZATION WAS FORMED ONLY ABOUT 8 YEARS AGO....AND ACTS AS THE PUBLIC'S VOICE WHEN IT COMES TO THE HEALTH OF LOCAL WATERWAYS...CREEKS AND MARSHES.

BETWEEN MAY AND OCTOBER...WATERKEEPER TESTS THE WATERS OF THOSE AREAS FREQUENTED BY RESIDENTS. THESE AREAS INCLUDE SHEM CREEK...HOBCAW CREEK...JAMES ISLAND CREEK...WAPOO CUT...BATTERY BEACH....AS WELL AS OTHER AREAS.

WHILE FEDERAL AND STATE AGENCIES TEST A LOT OF THE WATERS...THE CREEKS AND MARSHES WERE NEGLECTED WITH SOME AREAS NOT TESTED FOR MORE THAN 10 YEARS BEFORE CHARLESTON WATERKEEPER STARTED ITS TESTING.

AND WHILE MANY LOOK AT THE HEAVY RAINS IN THE LOW COUNTRY AS A GOOD THING....WUNDERLY SAYS HE FRETS WHEN HE THINKS OF ALL THE RAIN. THAT RAIN WASHES OILS...FERTILIZER...PESTICIDES AND OTHER BAD THINGS INTO THE WATERWAYS.

AND HE ADVISES THAT WHEN THE HEAVY RAINS FILL AND FLOOD OUR NEIGHBORHOODS...NEVER INTERACT WITH THOSE WATERS. IT MAY SEEM FUN...BUT THE WATERS ARE FILLS WITH CHEMICALS AND SUBSTANCES THAT CAN MAKE US SICK.

### CAROLINA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT...HELPING AT RISK AND ABUSE YOUTH THRU TO YOUNG ADULTHOOD

AIR DATE: AUGUST 12, 2018

GUEST: BEVERLY HARDIN...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE NON-PROFIT CAROLINA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AGENCY

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE MISSION OF THE AGENCY AND HOW IT HELPS AT- RISK AND ABUSED JUVENILES. THE ORGANIZATION HAS ITS ROOTS IN THE LATE 1700's IN CHARLESTON. IT IS AN UMBRELLA AGENCY THAT WORKS WITH CHILDREN AND TEENS IN CRISIS.

THE KIDS COME TO THE AGENCY THRU THE COURTS AND THE DEPT OF SOCIAL SERVICES. THE AGENCY WORKS TO PROVIDE A SAFE PLACE FOR THE KIDS TO STAY WHILE PROBLEMS WITH THEIR FAMILIES ARE REMEDIED. THESE KIDS OF OFTEN ABUSED AND NEGLECTED. THEY NEED A LOT OF HELP TO BOUNCE BACK FROM SUCH TRAUMAS...AND ALSO GROW UP.

AS WE NEAR THE START OF THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR...CAROLINA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT'S WORK CONTINUES IN OUR OF THE SCHOOLS...AS THESE AFFECTED KIDS CONTINUE TO GROW.

FAMILES SITUATIONS TRY AND BE HEALED...BUT THAT DOES NOT ALWAYS HAPPEN. AND HELP IS ON THE WAY FOR THOSE WHO ARE GETTING READY TO AGE OUT OF THE SYSTEM VIA A TRANSITIONAL HOME WHERE THESE YOUNG PEOPLE CAN PREPARE FOR THE ADULT WORLD.

### FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IS TOMORROW....KNOW HOW TO DRIVE AROUND BUSES....SCHOOLS....AND BUS STOPS

AIR DATE: AUGUST 19, 2018

GUEST: LANCE CORPORAL MATT SOUTHERN...LOW COUNTRY SPOKESMAN FOR THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND HIGHWAY PATROL.

DISCUSSION WAS A BRUSH-UP ON THE RULES MOTORISTS ARE REQUIRED TO ABIDE BY STARTING AUGUST 20<sup>TH</sup>...WHICH IS THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.

RULES INCLUDE WHEN TO STOP FOR A SCHOOL BUS. FOR THE RECORD YOU STOP FOR A BUSES ON TWO LANE ROADWAYS. YOU DO NOT STOP FOR THE BUS ON A MULTI LANE ROAD IF YOU ARE TRAVELING IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION OF THE BUS.

SOUTHERN ALSO STRESSED THE NEED FOR PARENTS TO TALK TO THEIR TEEN DRIVERS WHO MAY BE DRIVING TO SCHOOL FOR THE FIRST TIME. NO TEXTING WHILE DRIVING...NO DISTRACTED DRIVING.

AND KIDS IN NEIGHBORHOODS WALKING TO BUS STOPS SHOULD BE INSTRUCTED TO STAY OUT OF THE ROAD WHILE WAITING FOR THE BUS. THIS IS ESSENTIAL...ESPECIALLY IF THE BUS STOP IS ON A BUSY ROADWAY. KIDS SHOULD ALSO BE INSTRUCTED ON BICYCLE RIDING RULES.

RESPONSIBILITY RESTS WITH DRIVERS AND STUDENTS.

# THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED....WORKING TO GET KIDS READY FOR SCHOOL

AIR DATE: AUGUST 26, 2018

<u>GUEST:</u> BROOKS HARKEN....DIRECTOR OF PROGRAMS WITH THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED IN CHARLESTON

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON HOW THE ASSOCIATION IS REACHING OUT TO TITLE-1 SCHOOLS IN GIVING YOUNG STUDENTS FREE EYE EXAMS, GLASSES AND TREATMENTS IF NECESSARY.

THE ASSOCIATION IS TEAMING UP WITH THE STORM EYE INSTITUTE AS WELL AS OTHER EYE PROFESSIONALS IN GIVING THESE EXAMS.

STUDENTS....EVEN THOSE AS YOUNG AS 3 YEARS OF AGE....CAN HAVE EYE PROBLEMS. IF A 'LAZY'EYE IS DIAGNOSED....IT CAN BE CORRECTED IF FOUND EARLY. OTHER JUVENILE EYE PROBLEMS CAN BE FOUND AND FIXED. EYE HEALTH AND THE DIAGNOSIS OF PROBLEMS CAN BE CORRECTED...HELPING STUDENTS EXCEL.

EYE PROBLEMS IN KIDS ARE FREQUENTLY FOUND 'JUST IN TIME' AND CORRECTED. IT'S AN IMPORTANT ASPECT TO THE EDUCATION CAREER. A STUDENT WHO CANNOT SEE PROPERLY CAN EASILY STOP LEARNING. IT BECOMES A DOWNHILL TREND.

#### THE CHARLESTON AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSEUM

AIR DATE: SEPTEMBER 2, 2018

GUEST: MICHAEL B. MOORE....PRESIDENT AND CEO OF THE CHARLESTON INTERNATIONAL AFRICAN MUSEUM

DISCUSSION CENTERED OF A HUGE MILESTONE FOR THIS EFFORT....THE SUCCESSFUL GOAL REACHED OF RAISING 75 MILLION DOLLARS FOR THE BUILDING OF THE MUSEUM.

IT HAS TAKEN A COUPLE OF YEARS TO RAISE THE MONEY...BUT THE CONCEPT WAS BORN ALMOST 20 YEARS AGO BY FORMER CHARLESTON MAYOR JOE RILEY. HE STARTED THINKING ABOUT SUCH A MUSEUM AFTER READING THE BOOK 'SLAVE IN THE FAMILY'. RILEY....MAYOR OF CHARLESTON FOR 40 YEARS...DECIDED THAT THE CITY NEEDED A MUSEUM TO TELL THE STORY OF THE SLAVE TRADE AND HOW IT BEGAN ON GADSDEN WHARF...ON THE CITY'S HISTORIC WATERFRONT. MOORE SAYS AFTER THE MUSEUM WAS PROPOSED....THE CONCEPT HAD TO BE SHOPPED TO HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE AS IT BECAME FORMULATED.

FINALLY.....THE EFFORT BEGAN IN EARNEST...AND THE GOAL REACHED. MOORE DESCRIBED THE MUSEUM AS BEING MULTI-FUNCTIONING. IT WILL BE A MEETING PLACE...AND EDUCATIONAL CENTER....AND A PLACE WHERE RESIDENTS CAN FIND ANCESTORS THRU TRACING FAMILY TREES.

MOORE ALSO SAYS IT WILL BE A MUSEUM FOR ALL PEOPLE...NOT JUST FOR BLACKS.

ITS HOPED GROUND CAN BE BROKEN IN 2019 AND OPEN IN 2021.

#### NUTRITION DURING THE BACK-TO-SCHOOL DAYS

AIR DATE: SEPTEMBER 9, 2018

GUEST: DEBRA PEITIPAIN...MUSC OFFICE OF HEALTH PROMOTION AND SPOKESPERSON FOR THE ACADEMY OF NUTRITION AND DIETECTICS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON CHANGING SCHEDULES AND TIME CONSTRAINTS THAT COME ALONG WITH THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR...AND HOW NUTRITION IS IMPACTED.

THE GOOD NEWS IS THAT PETITPAIN SAYS THERE ARE BETTER BAG LUNCHES FOR STUDENTS THAT PARENTS CAN MAKE FOR THEIR KIDS. HEALTHLIER CHOICES MEAN BETTER NUTRITION AND MORE ENJOYABLE LUNCHES THAT KIDS WILL ACTUALLY EAT DURING THE SCHOOL LUNCH PLAN.

ALSO IMPORTANT...DINNER HOURS FOR FAMILIES. SCHEDULES ARE JAM PACKED....BUT THE EVENING MEAL IS IMPORTANT FOR NUTRITION AND FOR THE FUNCTIONING FAMILY UNIT. PETITPAIN URGES PARENTS NOT TO RESORT TO THE GREASY BAG-O-BURGERS ROUTE SEVERAL TIMES A WEEK. SHE SAYS NUTRITIOUS MEALS CAN BE MADE IN ADVANCE WITH ALITTLE PREP TIME.

DURING THE SUMMERTIME....SCHEDULES CAN BE RELAXED. IT CAN BE TOUGH TO GET BACK INTO A SOLID ROUTINE AGAIN. BUT TO DO SO HELPS INSURE THE HEALTH OF FAMILY MEMBERS

#### CALLING ALL SENIORS FOR THE SENIOR SUMMIT

AIR DATE: SEPTEMBER 16, 2018

GUESTS: TAMARA PRUETT....CASE MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR OF THE EAST COOPER MEDICAL CENTER....AND MAUREEN MAGUIRE....BOARD MEMBER OF THE THOMASENA STOKES-MARSHAL CENTER AND ORGANIZER OF THE SEPTEMBER 22<sup>ND</sup> SENIOR SUMMIT IN MT PLEASANT.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON IMPORTANT ATTRACTIONS AT THE SUMMIT AT THE THOMASENA STOKES-MARSHAL SENIOR CENTER. MAGUIRE CALLS IT A 'ONE-STOP-SHOP' OF ALL THE IMPORTANT VENDORS AND AGENCIES IMPORTANT TO SENIORS. EVERYTHING FROM FREE HEALTH SCREENINGS TO EDUCATIONAL SEMINARS. THERE WILL EVEN BE GAMES, PRIZES, AND FOOD AT THE EVENT.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND? THOSE NEARING THOSE SENIOR YEARS ALONG WITH THOSE WHO LOVE THEM. TOURS OF THE SENIOR CENTER WILL ALSO BE OFFERED. THOSE WHO ATTEND WILL REPORTEDLY GET A NEW VIEW OF WHAT SENIOR LIVING IS LIKE FOR SENIORS.

MAGUIRE SAYS THE CENTER IS VIBRANT AND ACTIVE. SHE SAYS BRAND NEW EXERCISE ROOM EQUIPMENT HAS JUST BEEN PURCHASED...SINCE THE SENIOR WORE OUT THE OTHER EOUIPMENT.

PRUETT WAS ONHAND TO TALK ABOUT THE NUTS AND BOLTS OF WHAT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED BEFORE ANY OF US HIT OUR SENIOR YEARS. THREE YEARS AGO WHILE DRIVING...JENNY EXPERIENCED A HEART ATTACK. BEFORE THAT SHE NAPPED A LOT, EXPERIENCED BACK PAIN, GROUND HER TEETH AND WAS STRESSED OUT. BUT SHE THOUGH NOTHING OF IT UNTIL THE CARDIAC EVENT OCCURRED.

NOW...SHE SPREADS THE WORD THAT PREVENTING HEART PROBLEMS IS SIMPLE COMMON SENSE. IT BOILS DOWN TO A BETTER LIFESTYLE. SHE NOW MAKES IT ESSENTIAL TO RELAX AND NOT STRESS OUT. SHE ALSO EATS MORE FRUITS AND VEGGIES AND MAKES TIME FOR HERSELF. IT'S NOT SELFISH....IT'S LIFESAVING.

ON OCTOBER 13<sup>TH</sup> IS THE ALWAYS POPULAR 'WALK A MILE IN HER SHOES' FUNDRAISER IN PARK CIRCLE. NOTABLE MEN IN THE LOW COUNTRY WILL WALK PARK CIRCLE WEARING HIGH HEELS. AND ALL DURING THE MONTH....YOU ARE INVITED TO HOLD 'A PARTY WITH A PURPOSE'. MY SISTER'S HOUSE PROVIDES EVERYTHING NEEDED TO HOLD YOUR OWN EVENT AT YOUR HOME TO DISCUSS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

EVERY YEAR SOUTH CAROLINA RANKS IN THE TOP 5 STATES WITH THE HIGHEST NUMBERS OF THOSE WOMEN KILLED IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INCIDENTS. THE LATEST NUMBERS ON THAT STAT ARE DUE OUT IN OCTOBER.

MY SISTER'S HOUSE IS ALMOST ALWAYS FULL. THE SHELTER OFFERS NOT ONLY A SAFE PLACE FOR BATTERED WOMEN AND THEIR KIDS...BUT ALSO CONNECTS WOMEN TO JOB TRAINING...FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE....AND ONGOING COUNSELING.
