Each CASA volunteer advocates on behalf of one child or family at a time, as opposed to the full caseloads managed by DHS workers and lawyer-guardians ad litem. These volunteers stay with each case until it is closed and the child or sibling group is placed in a safe, permanent home.

Guest: Foster Parenting

Cumulus Saginaw's Nate Rose and April Rose interviewed several Foster placement specialists and Foster parents. **Foster care** is a system in which a minor has been placed into a ward, group home, or private home of a state-certified caregiver, referred to as a **"foster parent**". The placement of the child is normally arranged through the government or a social service agency.
