AS NOTED IN EXHIBIT 13, AN ENTITY UNDER COMMON CONTROL WITH THE PROPOSED ASSIGNEE IS LICENSEE OF RADIO BROADCAST STATIONS WMBA(AM), AMBRIDGE, PENNSYLVANIA AND WBPV(AM), BEAVER FALLS, PENNSYLVANIA (FACILITY ID NUMBERS 17266 AND 52746, RESPECTIVELY) AND PERMITTEE OF A NEW FM STATION IN CLARENDON, PENNSYLVANIA, (FILE NUMBER BNPH-20041222ABA, FACILITY ID NUMBER 164188).

THERE ARE TWO RADIO MARKETS INVOLVED IN THE ACQUISITIONS PROPOSED HEREIN. THE STATIONS IN EACH OF THESE TWO RESPECTIVE MARKETS DO NOT OVERLAP ANY OF THE STATIONS IN THE OTHER MARKET.

OF THE THE STATIONS ALREADY LICENSED TO THE PROPOSED ASSIGNEE. WMBA(AM), AMBRIDGE AND

WBPV(AM), BEAVER FALLS ARE PART OF THE PITTSBURGH ARBITRON RADIO MARKET, AS DEFINED BY BIA DATA. NONE OF THE STATIONS PROPOSED TO BE ACQUIRED HEREIN ARE IN THE PITTSBURGH ARBITRON MARKET. CONSEQUENTLY, THERE WILL BE NO CHANGE IN THE ASSIGNEE'S OWNERSHIP IN THAT MARKET, WHICH CONSISTS OF 65 COMMERCIAL AND NONCOMMERCIAL RADIO BROADCAST STATIONS. SECTION 73.3555(A)(1)(I) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES PERMITS COMMON OWNERSHIP OF UP TO 8 STATIONS, OF WHICH NO MORE THAN 5 ARE IN THE SAME (AM OR FM) SERVICE, IN A MARKET OF THAT SIZE. AS A RESULT OF THE ACQUISITION PROPOSED HEREIN, THE ASSIGNEE WILL CONTINUE TO OWN 2 STATIONS IN THE PITTSBURGH MARKET, BOTH OF WHICH WILL BE IN THE SAME (AM) SERVICE.

THE ASSIGNEE'S ATTRIBUTABLE PERMIT IN CLARENDON AND ALL THREE OF THE STATIONS PROPOSED TO BE ACQUIRED HEREIN ARE OUTSIDE ALL ARBITRON MARKETS, ACCORDING TO THE BIA DATABASE. ATTACHED HERETO IS AN ENGINEERING STUDY THAT DEMONSTRATES COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 73.3555(A)(1)(III) OF THE RULES. FIGURES 1 AND 2 LIST AND DEPICT 4 AM STATIONS WHOSE PRIMARY SERVICE CONTOURS OVERLAP THOSE OF AT LEAST ONE OF THE STATIONS TO BE COMMONLY OWNED. FIGURES 3 AND 4 LIST AND DEPICT 13 FULL-POWER FM STATIONS WHOSE PRIMARY SERVICE CONTOURS OVERLAP THOSE OF AT LEAST ONE OF THE STATIONS TO BE COMMONLY OWNED. (3 LPFM STATIONS ARE ALSO LISTED BUT NOT COUNTED FOR PURPOSES OF THIS DEMONSTRATION.) CONSEQUENTLY, THIS 'MARKET' CONSISTS OF 21 STATIONS, OF WHICH ONLY 4 (3 IN THE SAME FM SERVICE) ARE TO BE COMMONLY OWNED AS THE RESULT OF THE ACQUISITION PROPOSED HEREIN.

THUS THE ACQUISITION WILL COMPLY WITH THE FCC'S LOCAL RADIO OWNERSHIP RULES.
