The Management of KINN-FM, in cooperation with community leaders, organizations serving our local community and a cross section of our audience have helped determine the following issues of importance to the Alamogordo area.

- 1) Annual Thrive in Southern New Mexico's Day of Caring
- 2) Blood Drive at The New Mexico School for the Blind and Visually Impaired
- 3) Annual Veteran's Day Parade
- 4) Mountain View Assembly of God Thanksgiving Outreach Dinner
