Keogh offers FREE enrollment assistance for AHCCCS (Arizona's Medicaid), KidsCare, Marketplace Health Insurance (The Affordable Care Act), Our Navigators are advocates and teachers who care for and support our clients on the road to self-sufficiency. Keogh understands that health is more important than health insurance. In 2016, we began to identify and train qualified Community Health Workers/Promotores de Salud to link health care providers and patients, identify available social services, and teach healthy living and disease management. Community Health Workers are not just an extension of core clinical services; they are key to providing effective primary care and supporting our goals.
