INFORMATION GIVEN ON THE ANNUAL DUCK RACE TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE MAIN ST. TOURISM PROGRAM AND THE ANNUAL 1860'S STREET PLAY PUT ON BY COMMUNITY MEMBERS FEATURING A STORY OF LIFE BASED ON TRUE EVENTS IN THE HISTORY OF THE COUNTY.

CATHY HORTON INTERVIEWED MARY MCCORVIE, HERITAGE PROGRAM MANAGER WITH THE SHAWNEE NATIONAL FOREST, GILLUM FERGUSON, AUTHOR OF ILLINOIS HISTORY ARTICLES AND TOURISM GUIDE, AND CHARLIE HAMMOND, VISUAL HISTORIAN. TOURISM CONTINUES TO BE AN ECONOMIC ENGINE FOR SOUTHERN ILLINOIS WITH ITS UNIQUE HISTORY AND SCENIC BEAUTY. IN AN EFFORT TO

CONTINUE TO PROMOTE THE REGION THE FRIENDS OF THE SHAWNEE, A NON-PROFIT GROUP, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SHAWNEE NATIONAL FOREST SERVICE HAVE ORGANIZED A BUS TOUR OF THE HISTORIC SITES IN THE SHAWNEE, COMPLETE WITH MEALS AND TOUR GUIDE. THESE TOURS WILL BE BASED ON THE ORIGINAL 1930'S TOURS WITH L.O. TRIGG, FORMER ELDORADO NEWSPAPER OWNER AND EARLY PROMOTER OF SOUTHERN ILLINOIS. IT WAS MR. TRIGG, THAT THROUGH HIS EFFORTS IN ORGANIZING THESE TOURS WITH MEMBERS OF U.S. CONGRESS AND STATE REPRESENTATIVES IN THE 30'S HELPED GET THE SHAWNEE FOREST IT'S FEDERAL DESIGNATION. THE FRIENDS OF THE SHAWNEE HOPE TO OFFER THESE TOURS EVERY YEAR AND HELP TO BRING MORE TOURISTS TO THE AREA FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. THERE WAS A CHARGE FOR THE TOURS AND ANY FUNDS AFTER EXPENSES WOULD GO TO THE FRIENDS OF THE SHAWNEE FOR FURTHER TOURISM PROMOTION. THE TOURS HAVE BEEN NAMED, THE OZARK TOURS.
