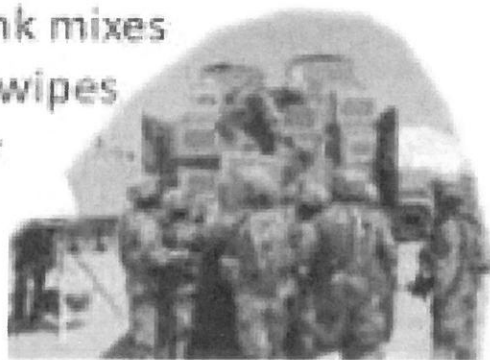
The USO of Northern Ohio ships care packages weekly to overseas-deployed members of the military who are from the 31 northernmost counties of Ohio.

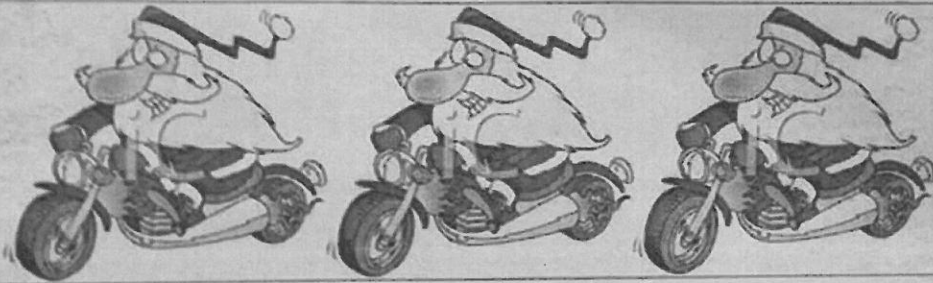
