Diane Less is the co-founder of Angels for Animals in Canfield. Angels for Animals provides a no-kill shelter for dogs and cats. Diane discusses the importance of spaying and neutering these animals. One female cat that produces a litter in early spring will result in 35 cats born by year's end. Diane notes that the key to controlling the animal population is to prevent unwanted & homeless animals from being born. Angels for animals is currently offering a "2 for 1" spaying and neutering program for cats and encourages people feeding 'free roaming' cats to bring them in for the procedure. Diane also discussed various fundraisers the shelter sponsors including the Garage Sale at the Canfield Fairgrounds.
