Becky Miller represents Second Harvest Foodbank of the Mahoning Valley which includes Mahoning, Trumbull and Columbiana counties. Becky discusses the current need for emergency food assistance which has increased over the past year. Each week the Foodbank is filling more than 15,000 requests for emergency food assistance. Hunger Awareness Day on 9/3/15 will kick off a fall food and funds drive. The Foodbank is asking supporters to help create awareness of the issue by wearing orange on that day.

“Each week the Food Bank is filling more than 15,000 requests for emergency food assistance in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull counties,” said Michael Iberis, executive director, Second Harvest Food Bank

Second Harvest Food Bank of the Mahoning Valley’s mission is to solicit, store and distribute food to hunger-relief organizations feeding people in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull counties; and to provide education and advocacy.

Second Harvest Food Bank of the Mahoning Valley, a member of Feeding America, distributes food to 153 hunger relief organizations in Columbiana, Mahoning and Trumbull counties. These organizations include church pantries, homeless shelters and soup kitchens, shelters for battered women and after-school programs. In 2014, the Food Bank distributed 9.5 million pounds of food, including 2 million pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables in the tri-county area.


