MYCAP ENROLLMENT FOR HEAD START/EARLY HEAD START SCHEDULED TO BEGIN

Even though the start of the school year is a few weeks away, the Mahoning Youngstown Community Action Partnership (MYCAP) will have new enrollment and re-enrollment for their Head Start/Early Head Start program from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. on four consecutive Fridays beginning this Friday, July 19.

During the upcoming school year there will be nine Head Start/Early Head Start sites throughout Mahoning County.

The first enrollment session is on July 19, at the MYCAP Administrative Office, 1325 Fifth Avenue in Youngstown. The second enrollment is July 26, at the McCartney Learning Center, 1988 McCartney Road in Youngstown. On August 2, enrollment will take place at the Renaissance Learning Center, 345 Oak Hill in Youngstown and the final session is on August 9, at Westchester Learning Center, 122 Westchester Drive in Austintown.

If parents are re-enrolling their children they do not have to complete another application, but there will be screenings for vision, hearing, height, weight, blood pressure and developmental skills.

If parents are enrolling their children for the first time, they will need to complete an application and should bring the following information:

1. Child's Proof of Birth & Shot Record
2. Medical or Insurance Card
3. Custody Papers (if applicable)
4. Social Security Cards for entire family
5. Income documentation (Please bring the most recent pay stubs, with employer's name, address and phone number)
6. Two individual's names, telephone number and addresses for emergency contacts
7. Your child's pediatrician and dentist – names, addresses and phone numbers

In addition, all children enrolling for the first time must be income eligible depending on the family size according to the federal poverty guidelines listed below:

Household Size **Annual Gross Income**

1	\$11,490
2	\$15,510
3	\$19,530
4	\$23,550
5	\$27,570
6	\$31,590
7	\$35,610
8	\$39,630

Families with more than eight people in the household should add \$4,020 per person to their annual gross income.

Other local nonprofit agencies will be on hand with information about their services. There will also, be games refreshments, a bounce-around and face painting available during enrollment.

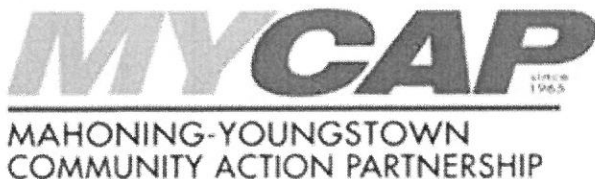
The Head Start Program is a program of the United States Department of Health and Human Services that provides comprehensive education, health, nutrition and parent involvement services to income eligible children and their families. It's open to children six weeks of age to five years old.

The program's services and resources are designed to foster stable family relationships, enhance children's physical and emotional well-being and establish an environment to develop strong reasoning skills.

MYCAP IN YOUNGSTOWN HAS NINE BASIC COMPUTER CLASSES SCHEDULED IN JULY

Mahoning County residents who want to learn the basics of how to use a computer and the internet are encouraged to sign up for one of nine free Computer Literacy Classes scheduled in July at the Mahoning Youngstown Community Action Partnership (MYCAP), 1325 Fifth Avenue, Youngstown.

The classes are free, for adults 18 years of age and over, and made possible through the 'Every Citizen Online Grant from Connect Ohio.

However, these sessions are not for those who already have some understanding of computers, but are for those who have no knowledge or skills when they sit behind a computer keyboard or monitor. The three-session class focuses on: Introduction to Computers, Microsoft for Beginners and Introduction to the Internet.

Participants must attend three, two-hour sessions. Upcoming class dates and times are:

1. July 16, 17 & 18 – 10:00 a.m. – Noon
2. July 16, 17 & 18 – 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.
3. July 16, 17 & 18 – 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

4. July 23, 24 & 25 – 10:00 a.m. – Noon
5. July 23, 24 & 25 – 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.
6. July 23, 24 & 25 – 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

7. July 29, 30 & 31 – 10:00 a.m. – Noon
8. July 29, 30 & 31 – 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.
9. July 29, 30 & 31 – 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

The goal is to help as many people as possible learn the basic functions of a computer keyboard, a mouse, how to email and how to access the internet. Both work and leisure often center on being computer savvy, so it's an opportunity to learn some general information that is immediately useful.

However, because there are a limited number of computers at the MYCAP office on Fifth Avenue in Youngstown you must register in advance by calling Kim at the MYCAP office at 330-747-7921, ext. 1190.

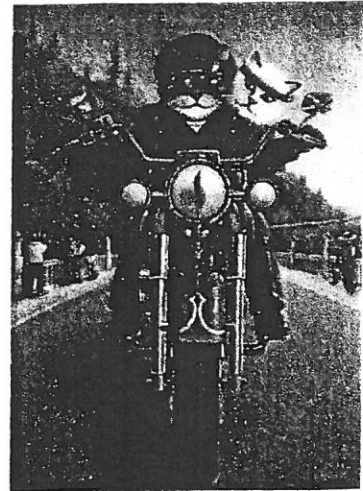
