We have continued to cover multiple meetings and community events to aid the community in social distancing requirements.

We at KQKI provide 4 live local news broadcast - Monday through Friday (24 minutes daily)(2 hours weekly-26 hours total in 3 months)

We broadcast news 24 hours a day at the top of each hour, over 5 hours weekly.
We broadcast Louisiana Network News 16 times daily totaling over 5 hours weekly.

We also attend and report on local governmental meetings for the Morgan City Council, Berwick Council, Patterson Council, Franklin Council, and St. Mary Parish School Board.
