Dear employer and university representative:

We would like to share a brief report on the 2015 Career & Job Fair, arguably, the most successful career fair in terms of student participation, employer participation, students interviewed and/or hired on the spot, hospitality and community participation. Those that have participated in the previous six years from CLFC and college staff, employers and university participants attested to that fact in their survey evaluations. We had 53 employers, 23 universities, and 7 MSJC departments represented and over 680 students and community members at the fair.

On the department, employer and university representative evaluation on a scale of 1-5, 1 being least favorable and 5 being the most positive, we were given an overall rating of 4.8. Participants were asked to rate the registration process, level of organization, hospitality, floor plan, directions, itinerary and overall experience.

There are several offices or programs in the district that merit kudos for sponsoring with money and/or human resources such as the Career/Transfer Center, STEM, Nursing Program, IT, and the Public Information Office. From the community we thank profusely the California Family Life Center (CFLC) - Empower Youth who without the plethora of donations they contribute to the event and their dedicated workers who consistently come to the planning meetings as well as the event, the Career Job Fair would not be such a great success. Moreover, it was because of CFLC staff that we had a record community attendance.

We thank you for your commitment to participating in our annual Career Job Fairs. We look forward to your participation in next year's fair. Please be assured that we took your input in our evaluation survey into account. We will use the collective input to improve and have an even better event.
