She was a Black Civil War Nurse who started secret “bucket schools” for Black children in Savannah during time when it was illegal for Black people to read & write. Gullah Geechee Historian Sista Patt Gunn was the driving force behind the push to rename the square. She joined us via Zoom with details on how it happened.

September 10 - Savannah Police School Zone Cameras, Susie King Taylor Square

- The subjects in last week’s show are still gaining a lot of traction & discussion. The intro and some of the PSA padding were freshened up and the interviews were re-aired.

September 17 - FODAC Savannah Music Festival, I-95/Cumulus Savannah Diaper Drive
