Section I: Issues

The stations have identified the following as significant issues facing the community in this quarter.

- A. Student Life: The Dubuque metro is home to six local four-year institutions of higher learning: Loras College, Clarke University, University of Dubuque, University of Wisconsin—Platteville, Emmaus Bible College and Divine Word College. The area is also served by three community colleges: Northeast lowa Community College, Southwestern Wisconsin Technical College and Highland Community College. A large gap exists in the way young adults perceive sexually appropriate behavior. Townsquare/Dubuque stations aired a program that provided information about what constitutes sexual consent, assault, sexual abuse and the consequences of that abuse.
- **B. Diversity:** As the market becomes more culturally and racially diverse, residents need to be aware of how their actions can affect others. Townsquare/Dubuque stations aired programs that provided information about diversity issues and education. These programs discussed diversity through the lens of pop culture, laws that continue to promote segregation, and how American cities faced diversity issues, including removing statutes commemorating the Confederacy.
- **C. Environmental Awareness**: Though the market has several programs to raise awareness of environmental issues, surveys indicate more education should be offered regarding this issue. Townsquare/Dubuque stations aired programming involving discussions of how gardening can affect climate change and the long-term consequences of global warming.
- **D. Domestic Violence:** One in four women will be victims of domestic violence and the number of victims murdered by their partners has increased 20 percent. Townsquare/Dubuque stations aired programming discussing how domestic violence continues to persist and what can be done, as well as airing interviews with two domestic violence survivors who shared their experiences.
- **E. School Issues:** Townsquare/Dubuque stations aired programs which focused on issues facing public primary and secondary schools. These programs focused on such topics as the importance of revamping school lunch menus to improve nutrition and the importance of recess on younger student mental health.

Section II: Responsive Programming

The stations air responsive programming in the form of a weekly 30-minute program, VIEWPOINTS RADIO. Viewpoints airs each Sunday at 11pm on KLYV (FM), 6:30am on KXGE (FM), 9am on WDBQ (AM), 6am on WDBQ-FM and 10:30pm on WJOD (FM). The program addresses the issues identified as significant to the community as well as a variety of other related topics. A comprehensive description of the Viewpoints programs is presented in the following pages.
