Dr. Wonder's Workshop is targeted toward deaf and hard-of-hearing children, but is also perfect for hearing children who can't speak because of illness or disability, people learning English as a second language, stroke victims, and educators who work with children. E/I age range is 7-12 year old.

Scaly Adventures

The *Scaly Adventures* cast, composed of Pierce, Tanya and Rick Curren, traveled the world featuring many different animals, as well as their own reptiles. The purpose of the show is not only to teach what reptiles are really like, but also to inspire kids through family-friendly programming. Each episode focuses on teaching children how they should "interact with, care for, and protect animals."

Missing

Missing is a weekly half-hour educational/informational series focusing on actual cases of missing persons. The series, which is appropriate for family viewing and children ages 13-16 in particular, provides information and descriptions of missing children, including endangered runaways as well as victims of abductions. The show also presents peer-to-peer advice on safety in public places and in cyber space, including real-world examples of how to avoid potentially dangerous situations. The program emphasizes taking active responsibility for personal safety and promotes situational awareness, presented in a calm and non-threatening manner suited for teenagers. E/I age range is 13-16 years old.

Biz Kids

Biz Kid\$ is a weekly half-hour series focusing on financial literacy and entrepreneurship for teens, targeting 13 to 16-year-olds. Using a mix of strong financial education tools, dynamic sketch comedy, and inspiring true stories of young entrepreneurs, Biz Kid\$ provides important information for future success. Each episode features math, language arts, and social studies as well as teaching teens about money and business.

Elizabeth Stanton's Great Big World

Elizabeth Stanton has been a world traveler her entire life. From an early age she has experienced the culture of Europe, the wonders of the Far East and the natural beauty of remote destinations. In her own syndicated television series, *Elizabeth Stanton's Great Big World*, Elizabeth travels the globe with her celebrity friends exploring other cultures, learning about history and finding opportunities to help out those in need, while shedding some light on what others less fortunate are dealing with. The series is a top rated show on FOX affiliates nationwide and can be seen in 90% of the US.

Elizabeth is very passionate about giving back and is a supporter of Marines Toys for Tots Foundation, donating thousands of toys to the organization over the last few years. In addition, she has donated money earned from her show to the homeless men, women, and children of Los Angeles, ultimately helping to feed over 4000 families in Los Angeles for two months.

She continues to film new episodes of *Great Big World*, which recently celebrated a 100th episode milestone. E/I age group 13-16 years old.

Kid's Beach Club TV

KiDs Beach Club TV is a multi-award winning, weekly children's 30-minute television show that follows a group of pre-teen students as they navigate life, learn character lessons in the KBC Clubhouse and discover how God can transform them through the pages of His Word, the Bible.

DragonflyTV

DragonflyTV is an Emmy-Award winning science education television series produced by Twin Cities Public Television. The show aired on PBS Kids from 2002 to 2008, with reruns until 2010 on selected stations. Seasons 1–4 were cohosted by Michael Brandon Battle and Mariko Nakasone. Seasons 5–7 were hosted by Eric Artell and are produced in partnership with science museums. DragonflyTV was created in collaboration with Project Dragonfly at Miami University, which founded Dragonfly magazine, the first national magazine to feature children's investigations and discoveries. DragonflyTV pioneered a "real kids, real science" approach to children's science television and led to the development of the SciGirls television series.^[1] DragonflyTV and SciGirls were funded in part by the National Science Foundation to provide a national forum for children's scientific investigations. Reruns of DragonflyTV air in offnetwork syndication to allow commercial stations to meet federal E/I mandates.

Sonja Hegwood was brought up in church, saying the "Sinner's Prayer" and was baptized ...twice., however during her teen years left the faith in search of healing from the pain of losing her father to ALS. Sonja became pregnant at 17 and became a mom at 18. Her life changed incrementally, with pain and hurt masked in a busy life of a young mom trying to prove that she was capable and able to a world that seemed full of judgment. When her son was five, she married and shortly after welcomed a second child. Two years into her marriage she found herself with another pregnancy. Panicked and stricken with scars of the shame only a teen mom could vouch for quickly found an abortion clinic. This experience brought her to complete surrender to Christ. The work she does now as CEO of the Resource Pregnancy Center gives her an outlet to share His grace and be His hands and feet so that no one has to make decisions that they may regret from a lack of information or support.

October 18, 2021

Tracy Kemp's passion is her non-profit organization called In Touch Outreach. Their mission is to help motivate and inspire single moms and dads and single grandparents like herself. She's a published author of a book titled *Abused, Confused, Misused*. Tracy loves helping others in her community and showing God's love and letting the youth know they can be anything or have their heart desires as they find their purpose and passion. She resides in Atlanta, Georgia and will share more about her non-profit organization.

October 25, 2021

Terrell Scott was in prison for trafficking cocaine and robbery at gunpoint. The woman he robbed at gunpoint went to share the Gospel with him and a radical encounter with Christ transformed him. That same woman that shared Christ with him and the woman he robbed at gunpoint is now his wife, Brandy Scott. He is now the pastor of Passion Life Church located in Forest Park, Georgia and executive director of The River Refuge. The River Refuge is a nonprofit 501(c) (3) community development organization. The River Refuge program, the Malachi Project, is designed to provide families, children and individuals, who are in need, education both in spiritual matters as well as in life skills.

The Malachi Project is an after school program that follows the CRU Inner City curriculum established by S.A.Y. YES!. This stands for Save America's Youth! Yes! The Malachi Project exists to give our at-risk youth a chance of a better future that includes a solid education through help of tutors, opportunities of a career and a life sustained through good work ethic and moral values.

Under the unction of the Holy Spirit, and with the Spiritual guidance of Dr. Dave and Dr. Vernette Rosier of The Fellowship Churches of Praise, birthed The Fellowship Church of Praise of Atlanta. Pastor Janice Grier birthed this ministry in her living room with nine members present and her husband, Co-Pastor Elder Patrick H. Grier in 2007. Apostle Grier is spiritually motivated to work in the Kingdom. In 2007, she formed Reach beyond the Break Outreach Ministries (a community outreach program, which assists with food, clothing, housing and utility assistance). In 2009, God shifted the ministry! Pastor Janice Grier Founded Greater New and Living Way International Deliverance Ministries, Inc. She will share more about her ministry.

Also on the program is Dr. E. Dewey Smith. Dr. Smith is the Senior Pastor/Teacher of The House of Hope Atlanta and The House of Hope Macon – one church in two locations. A proud native of Macon, Georgia, he has been a minister of the gospel for thirty years. He commenced his preaching ministry at age of seventeen and his pastoral ministry at seventeen. God has highly favored Dr. Smith by allowing explosive growth and outreach to accompany his ministry.

Dr. Smith has always had a passion to redress those things that plague the community and burden the people he serves. As a result, he has launched several initiatives that have had significant impact. Throughout his ministry he has been heavily involved in prison reform, re-entry programs, human services and community development. In 2013, Dr. Smith launched Tabitha's House, a non-profit organization that provides housing, counseling and support to young girls rescued from human trafficking. His congregation is one of the few churches in the nation that owns a resource center and two residences that house and empower victims of human trafficking. In addition, Smith opened the Haven House, a fully staffed, professional and licensed counseling center that addresses the emotional and mental health concerns of people in the community.
