Nixlot is the child of Haitian immigrant parents; his lack of grasp on the English language made him a prey in his community and school. He became the target of several gang attacks because of how poor he was as well.

Because Nixlot, grew up in a Christian home he knew that there would be no fighting so, instead of building his mind and muscles to retaliate, he decided to try bodybuilding, and by the age of seventeen, he had already won eight bodybuilding titles under the World Physique Federation and was qualified to represent the United States at the World Championships in Brussels Belgium and Slovenia twice.

He has since appeared on several national media platforms and has spoken at a number of different schools, churches and media platforms on the effects and solutions to bullying, mental health and wellness. From elementary schools to colleges such as Temple University, he is currently contouring bodies worldwide as he continues to prepare for more international competition. What many people don't know is that Nixlot suffers from a rare heart disease which the doctors told him that he would never heal from when he was just fifteen. With this disease, he was forbidden to exercise or do any kind of heavy lifting and exhaustive work. Nix has defied the odds; he is obviously still alive and thriving. Having lived in the dark shadows of guilt, shame, and embarrassment that birthed feelings of inadequacy, Ceola is passionate about eradicating low self-esteem and self-worth among women and helping them build healthy self-images. As I continue sharing my past fears, failures, guilt, shame, and embarrassing experiences, and my victory, I will encourage a multitude of other women that all things are possible through Christ Jesus and that He does make all things new" She shares her past and how she was able to rise up and allow God to lead her to where she needed to be.

Also, Heather Hantz was a guest. She was born in South Louisiana and raised in Baton Rouge. She graduated from Our Lady of the Lake College with a diploma in Surgical Technology and Healing Place School of Ministry with a diploma in Christian Ministry. He is also host of the NBC Thanksgiving television tradition, *The National Dog Show*.

John O'Hurley has entertained and inspired thousands with his hilarious and deeply personal memoir, *The Peterman Guide to the Extraordinary Life*, in which he outlines the signposts for an authentic and more purposeful life. It is based on his refinement of a single statement said to him more than twenty years ago, a statement that changed his life.

Since then, his life has been nothing short of a renaissance. He carved his way into American pop culture in both television and film, most notably with his portrayal of the wildly eccentric character, J. Artur went to one of the best high schools in Poland and later started traveling around Europe becoming a very successful smuggler. In 1995, he immigrated to Canada.

In his first two years in Calgary, he went through depressions which included suicidal moods, and heavy drinking. Eventually he met and married his wife Marzena whom got him back on his feet, introduced him to Christianity. After his first son was born in 2000, being given the report that the child would not live due to severe birth defects was asked to remove him from life support. Artur and his wife refused and began to pray for their son. A few days later, through supernatural intervention, their prayers were answered. The boy defied all odds and was totally healed. From that time, Artur began charity work with the homeless on the streets of Calgary while continuing with his businesses. Through the years he managed to form a number of policies that were implemented by the government to improve the lives of the poor in Canada. She shares a little of her testimony then brings the Word of God, always giving altar calls. Prior to her transformation she signed herself into a government run treatment center, twice. Evangelist Kandi Rose now has 31 yrs. free, thanks to the only higher power, Jesus Christ. She committed her life to Jesus, at the leading of her mother over the phone. Wild America

Wild America documents the amazing lives and fascinating behavior of virtually every mammal, bird, fish, and reptile, as well as the natural wonders and scenic beauty, in the great American outdoors. Marty Stouffer, a respected authority on American wildlife, has created a unique weekly series that focuses on and celebrates our priceless national treasure of wildlife and wilderness. E/I age range is 13-16 years old. (August only)

Dr. Wonder's Workshop

Learn important lessons of faith and virtue with Dr. Wonder and all his friends on this unique, fun and educational kids' program.

Dr. Wonder's Workshop is targeted toward deaf and hard-of-hearing children, but is also perfect for hearing children who can't speak because of illness or disability, people learning English as a second language, stroke victims, and educators who work with children. E/I age range is 7-12 year old.

Young Explorers

The Young Explorers join filmmaker Timothy Mahoney, Director of *Patterns of Evidence: The Exodus*, on an adventure to investigate amazing evidence that matches the Bible. But there is more to the investigation than Tim lets on. He has a secret device, the Exploration Chamber. This holographic space allows the explorers to talk with real archaeologists, explore ancient evidence and visit the locations in Egypt and Israel where the events of the Exodus actually happened. Before each adventure they discover secret messages directing them to search their Bibles for clues in the text. What the Young Explorers find is a pattern of evidence that matches the Exodus and excites their faith. E/I age range is 13-16 year old.

Scaly Adventures

The series, which is appropriate for family viewing and children ages 13-16 in particular, provides information and descriptions of missing children, including endangered runaways as well as victims of abductions. The show also presents peer-to-peer advice on safety in public places and in cyber space, including real-world examples of how to avoid potentially dangerous situations. The program emphasizes taking active responsibility for personal safety and promotes situational awareness, presented in a calm and non-threatening manner suited for teenagers. E/I age range is 13-16 years old.

She relocated to Atlanta, Georgia in 2010 to join the Care and Counseling Center of Georgia (CCCG). Through CCCG, Patricia completed two units of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) at Metro State Women's Prison and Northside Hospital.

Patricia is married to an Atlanta native, Bert Gary, with whom she co-pastors at Owl Rock United Methodist Church in Atlanta.
