Topic: Health and Lifestyle

During 3rd Quarter 2022, WATC aired programming that addressed a healthier and more productive lifestyle and encouraged people to overcome obstacles in their own lives. Such programming included the following:

Friends & Neighbors

This half hour program features hosts Sherry Tatum, Sandra Onal and guest co-hosts. The series airs Monday through Wednesday at 6:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and Saturdays at 8:30 a.m. on WATC and Tuesday through Friday at 12:30 p.m. on WATC. WATC TV 57 Original Series.

August 9, 2022

Grace Fox is the author of *Keeping Hope Alive*. She says the proliferation of negative themes – COVID, war, violent crime, broken families, and news of environmental collapse all play into the negative cycle that leads to depression and hopelessness. She doesn't deny hardships but says people of faith seem to weather negative news better than people with no faith at all. Hopelessness is a byproduct of helplessness.

August 10, 2022

Susan Neal is an RN, health coach, and Christian who wants to show you how to reclaim your health and ideal weight by giving you knowledge about unhealthy foods, solutions for resolving negative eating habits, and ways to incorporate God into your healthy lifestyle. As a registered nurse with a master's degree in health science, Susan has used her medical knowledge and the Bible to recover her health and weight. "Unfortunately, he was given a short time to live, but man did he live, and man was his faith in God ever so strong," says Gober. Sarah Dickens became a Christian when she was eight years old. Even though she became saved, she did not know what it meant for her to draw really close to the Lord until her college years many years later because of circumstances that she went through in her childhood and teenage years that pulled her away from God in her early adult years because of circumstances surrounding her mental illness (bipolar disorder) and her mother's mental illness.

She met her ex- boyfriend in college, who she mentions in her book, and he was an atheist and pulled her further away from God. She did not become really deep into her relationship and walk with the Lord until around her sophomore year at Georgia College and State University when her friends from college introduced her to Bible study. The more that she went to Bible study, the more she drew closer to God and her ex- boyfriend broke up with her because he noticed that she was pulling further away from him and becoming closer to God. This circumstance surrounding the breakup with her ex-boyfriend changed her life because it was a turning point in her life. In spite of the circumstances surrounding her mental health diagnosis, God taught her through His Word to fully rely on Him in the times that she had episodes surrounding her bipolar disorder. She found many hobbies and passions of which she can actively serve the Lord (such as writing being her most favorite hobby of all hobbies), and make a difference in the lives of others.

She believes that God has called her to lead young adults and children (her target audiences in her writings) to a growing relationship with Jesus Christ through the outlet of writing, especially since she is a published author. Her

writings are intended to target both Christian and non-Christian young adults and children so that Christians can continue to thrive in their relationship with Christ while the non-Christians get a firm understanding as well as knowledge of who Christ is as Lord and Savior. In this way, Christians and non-Christians who read her book will come into a deep sense of faith as well as a growing relationship with Jesus Christ. Host Aurea McGarry. Diane is trained to work with individuals, families, couples, and groups from a wide variety of backgrounds, populations, and ages in treating mental, behavioral, and emotional problems and disorders.

August 22, 2022

In 1988, Kyle Peacock was raised at the Smoky Mountain Children's Home in East Tennessee. After struggling early in life as an abused, handicapped orphan with extreme church hurt, Kyle was radically changed through his experiences on a mission trip to New York City. God burdened Kyle with a supernatural heart for New York City. In 2008 and at the age of twenty, he started leading mission trips to The Big Apple. In 2017, Kyle went all in by moving to Queens, New York so he could run mission trips year round. To date, Kyle has led over twelve thousand people on short-term mission trips, while leading multiple outreach events and training seminars for local New York City churches and organizations.

Currently, Kyle serves as an Urban Missionary with City Takers. The City Takers Movement has been serving Atlanta, Georgia for over fifteen years, and Kyle is helping expand their successful Urban Ministry Model into New York City, by leading mission trips, planting weekly micro churches, leading outreach training seminars, and community service events. He will share more about his ministry. Hosts Pastor John and Nikita Citizen. Fifteen minute interview within the one-hour program.

August 30, 2022

Margaret L. Conley is a Licensed Clinical Social worker in Georgia, Alabama, and Tennessee where she provides crisis services and trauma-focused clinical therapy. She is trained as a trauma therapist in EMDR, Internal Family Systems, Adlerian Play Therapy, and Brainspotting. Margaret is a Certified Daring Way Facilitator and LEGO Serious Play Facilitator. Margaret is a Certified Mental Health First Aid Instructor endorsed by the National Council for Mental Wellbeing.

Margaret has produced an evidence-based model which is a clinically aligned theological method designed for use by clergy, academics, and clinicians to help lead the conversation around Faith-Based Trauma in individual and community settings. She is the founder of Healthy and Holy Conversations and the producer of the Healthy and Holy Summit. God has called her to work with urbanized and marginalized population at the intersection of spirituality and emotional wellness. The work her soul must have is to see the church move from a Trauma-Inducing Theology in the form of spiritually bypassing the things that have happened toward a Trauma-Informed Theology that offers care from acknowledging things did happen and seeing how the riches of God can heal the inner man and have us rooted and ground filled with the love of Christ. She will share more about how she helps with the well-being of her community.

Dr. E. Dewey Smith is the Senior Pastor/Teacher of The House of Hope Atlanta and The House of Hope Macon – one church in two locations. A proud native of Macon, Georgia, he has been a minister of the gospel for thirty years. He commenced his preaching ministry at age of seventeen and his pastoral ministry at seventeen. God has highly favored Dr. Smith by allowing explosive growth and outreach to accompany his ministry. Smith has always had a passion to redress those things that plague the community and burden the people he serves. As a result, he has

launched several initiatives that have had significant impact. Throughout his ministry he has been heavily involved in prison reform, re-entry programs, human services and community development. In 2013, Dr. Smith launched The Tabitha's House, a non-profit organization that provides housing, counseling and support to young girls rescued from human trafficking. His congregation is one of the few churches in the nation that owns a resource center and two residences that house and empower victims of human trafficking. In addition, Smith opened the Haven House, a fully staffed, professional and licensed counseling center that addresses the emotional and mental health concerns of people in the community.

Evangelist Centoria Waters was molested by a family member at the age of ten. At that time, she was afraid, hurt and confused about what happened. Things got so bad for her that she wanted to commit suicide because no one would believe her when she told them what happened. Since then, she has built a relationship with God, learned how to trust Him and found her purpose. Her mission is to break a generational curse that has been tormenting her family for years. September 13, 2022

Tiffany D. Belcher is the Founder/C.E.O of We Win Kingdom Coaching. She has the passion for helping individuals and families who suffer from grief by assisting them in rebuilding their lives after the loss of a loved one. Tiffany also coaches women in reaching and maximizing their purpose in life through one on one mentoring. She is a graduate from Springfield College with a Master's Degree in Human Services. She currently resides in Milwaukee, Wisconsin with her four adult children. She will be talking about her ministry called The Prayer Zone. Host Koach Katlyn. Fifteen minute interview within the one-hour program.

September 14, 2022

In October 2015, Benny DiChiara, a singer, businessman, motivational speaker, father, and husband, endured a traumatic brain injury due to a fall. He suffered a concussion and closed fracture of the skull base with subarachnoid, subdural, and extradural hemorrhage. The injury could have easily ended his career and even his life. DiChiara astonished doctors with a rapid and nearly full recovery. The healing process turned into a creative season, during which Three Days was written. DiChiara spent four years in the U.S. Navy as a hospital corpsman, enjoyed success with a regional secular rock band and started a family. Five years following his divorce, he began attending church and came to a saving, personal knowledge of Jesus Christ.

In 1998, he married Donna Lyle Schram. The family now includes four grown children and nine grandchildren. DiChiara formed Empowered soon after becoming a Christian. Empowered has become a staple of the live music scene in their home state of Louisiana, sharing the stage with such powerhouse artists as Switchfoot, MercyMe, 7venth Time Down, and Jaci Velasquez. The band has an on-going partnership with Children's Cup, a ministry to the poorest of the poor in regions where AIDS is rampant, poverty is crushing, and the ranks of orphaned and vulnerable children continue to swell.

The songs on Three Days reflect the redemptive journey DiChiara has traversed. The title track points the listener to the miracle of the resurrection, while the song "Rock Bottom" alludes to God's unconditional grace. The song "Jeremiah 29:11," based on DiChiara's favorite scripture passage, was prompted by the Holy Spirit. DiChiara shares "God said to me, "Tell the people that what I did for you, I can do for them. All they have to do is lean into My presence." Host Yves McKenzie. September 20, 2022

Amy Walker was raised with faith in Jesus Christ and has always lived her life in a gospel centered way. When she was nineteen, she volunteered to teach English in Russia. While she was there, her testimony and commitment to centering her life around Christ grew as she had to rely on prayer, and she increased her commitment to serving the least of her brethren.

At the start of the pandemic, her whole world changed in a week. She went from having a full client roster and kids in school, attending church, to being a homeschooled parent, losing her biggest clients, and worshipping at home with her family. During that time, she turned to the Lord and felt such a sense of peace. The Lord has prepared her for these challenging times. "If we rely on Him, and center our lives around Him, we need not fear". "Be not weary in doing well!" Gal 6:9. She felt inspired this year to create the Northeast Georgia Preparedness Fair. The goal is to bring together the faith community to share resources to help members of her community weather the storms of life.

She resides in Commerce, Georgia and will be sharing why she created the Northeast Georgia Preparedness Fair and how she sees this being a blessing to her community. Host Aurea McGarry. Sixteen minute interview within the one-hour program.

September 21, 2022

Ashley Dudley was diagnosed late with Autism as an adult. She had many struggles growing up from being bullied by her peers and teachers, to being mad at God for making her that way. Her journey with Autism all began at birth. She was born four months (premature) early weighing less than one pound. She almost died at birth; her mother had to have an emergency C-section to get her out. Ashley's mom as well was not going make it either due to having preeclampsia. She was born so early and so tiny that one of her lungs collapsed and she had to stay in the NICU for three months to finish developing and gaining enough strength to go home to her family.

At the age of seven, she could never understand why she had to be isolated and put into another special classroom; she just wanted to be like the rest of her peers and be accepted. Her parents knew something was a bit different with me. She was late with all her milestones, very clumsy, extremely shy, no eye contact spoke late and had very little communication for her age range.

Fast forwarding to today as an adult, she now in her thirties, but when she was in her late twenties, that's when she decided to finally get some answers as to what and why her childhood such a "not so happy" place for her. After doing so much research on Autism, taking various online self diagnosis testing, and watching YouTube videos about autism, she then started to seek out Psychologists that specialize in autism diagnosis. She prayed hard and consistently on this and God really knew she wanted this done for her inner peace! In August of 2014, God provided her with an amazing Psychologist and she did a three day intense testing on her. After whole days of waiting for an answer, she told her that she's Autistic. She will share her story. Host Kay Thompson. Sixteen minute interview within the one-hour program.

September 23, 2022

Minstrel Appointed is a multi-award winning Christian recording artist who has been blessed to hit the Billboard Charts with her latest single, "Give Me a Heart". She is also the Executive Producer of The Spin Awards, the first and only platform that strictly honors those who spin the Gospel message.

Taking a cue from her name (Appointed means to select or designate to fill an office or a position), Appointed has filled the designation of the title of innovator. Ultimately, Appointed has come to realize the hard times that she has endured all have led to God being glorified through her life. She is a living, walking, breathing testimony to what God can do even with life's curveballs that are meant to harm but in His Providence they are useful for His Purpose to bless.

From drug addiction to Jesus addiction, from child abuse to Kingdom child empowerment from dark depression to insightful impression of what God can do, from homelessness to knowing her home is in heaven. Even domestic violence and child molestation has not stopped Appointed from serving, loving and experiencing the everlasting loving kindness of God towards her. For Appointed, the bottom line is ministry and only what's done for Christ will last.

Winston Grier was taught by his parents to live a life pleasing to God. He gave his life to Christ at a very young age; unfortunately he rebelled against his father's teaching. He left home his 10th grade year and lived a life selling drugs. In 2010, years later, he gave his life back to God. God granted him grace and mercy while living a life full of sin and that's why he turned back to God and his dad was there with open arms, treating him like a prodigal son. He believes that God has called him to teach, coach and speak to the world about kingdom principles.

September 28, 2022

In 2014, Ruby Manuel was diagnosed with stage three liver disease suffering from Hepatitis C. from drug and alcohol abuse. Thinking that she was at the end of her life, she married for the first time at fifty-four years old for companionship reasons. Neither she nor her then husband was in love with each other, however she did believe he had strong feelings for her, that they could make a go of being married, but that wasn't his plans, he married her for his own selfish reasons.

During her battle with stage three liver disease, she had so many challenges; first was the life threatening disease that was eating away at her liver, second was the infidelity of her cheating husband. She cried out to the Lord asking him to help her, to give her another chance to get it right, "Oh Lord God, please help me, there is none other than You that can make me whole!"; The voice of God spoke to her in the early afternoon of October 2013, verbatim, word for word, "Shave your balding head and go to your computer and begin writing again!" When she heard the voice of God speaking to her, she didn't argue with it, she shaved her balding head, went to her computer and began to compose her novel *The Suitcase*. She named it *The Suitcase* because she believed that her suitcase would be a great place to store her problems while she allowed her body to heal. Eight years later she's here to tell everyone the rest of her amazing life story. Host Juandolyn Stokes. Fifteen minute interview within the one-hour program.

Rhonda Green is focused on helping survivors of abuse beyond just bringing awareness to abuse. She is the author of an eBook titled *Seven Ways to Free Your Mind After Abuse*. Encore presentation.

August 24, 2022

G.M. Parks of Greenwood, South Carolina feels called to evangelize the nation to allow God to use her in deliverance and healing of the minds and emotional trauma. She is the author of *Rejected By Man, Loved By God*. Encore presentation.

August 31, 2022

Erica Strong is an overcomer. Erica asks, "Have you ever been betrayed, lied to, lied on, abused, abandoned, cheated on, belittled, demeaned, ridiculed, talked about, lost everything, divorced, embarrassed, depressed, confused, scared, broke, broken or judged just to name a few, then on top of it all did you find out that your health could have been in jeopardy when you found evidence that your spouse is on the down low? Well, I have... and am here to tell you, not only how I still have joy in my heart, but how I overcame and so can you. Dr. Wonder's Workshop

Learn important lessons of faith and virtue with Dr. Wonder and all his friends on this unique, fun and educational kids' program.

Dr. Wonder's Workshop is targeted toward deaf and hard-of-hearing children, but is also perfect for hearing children who can't speak because of illness or disability, people learning English as a second language, stroke victims, and educators who work with children. E/I age range is 7-12 year old.

The *Scaly Adventures* cast, composed of Pierce, Tanya and Rick Curren, traveled the world featuring many different animals, as well as their own reptiles.
