Issues/Program Lists for Third Quarter of 2017

“Our Faith, Our Diocese” is a monthly hour-long program that follows a news magazine format. It includes interviews, coverage of events and ministries, previews of upcoming activities, catechesis on the faith, and other segments, including how the Catholic Church serves the community through programs that provide assistance to the needy; address social issues such as hunger, homelessness, poverty, addictions, immigration and refugee resettlement, and family challenges; educate and inform people of all ages and offer spiritual sustenance to the residents of northeastern and north central Pennsylvania. Each program debuts the second Sunday of every month at 8 p.m. and then typically airs another six times during that month at various times during the daytime and evening hours. It is also available for viewing on the Diocesan website.

Catholic Television of the Diocese of Scranton also broadcasts the Daily Mass from St. Peter’s Cathedral in Scranton every weekday throughout the year at 12:10 p.m., with a few exceptions for holidays. CTV also broadcasts approximately 35 Pontifical Masses and ecumenical or interfaith services throughout the year, on Saturdays, Sundays, or weekday evenings.
