Each daypart dealt with these issues and solutions via pre-produced, ad libbed, and listener calls with available funding and resources. Among those solutions were available funding, cleanup of abandoned shopping carts, natural areas suitable for temp. housing.This effort began in January and has continued through March on all dayparts
Affordable housing	Morning, Mid Day, Afternoon Shows (6A-7P)	One major conversion of a former health facility in Coos Bay to small and inexpensive apartments received some special support in the form of a live broadcast for Eagle Crest Apartments. KLJN provided a grand opening broadcast specially aimed at relieving concerns of older apartment dwellers in the Bay Area.		While the event took place accompanied by a generous two-week promotional campaign on all dayparts in January, KLJN has continued to partner with the developers and with a local residential property management firm to introduce citizens to this facility that offers apartments that come with the bonus of security, church services, and light dining facility, all in one at Eagle Crest in Coos Bay.
