His book unpacks this idea and shows how to apply it to at least 7 areas of their lives: mind, eyes, ears, hands, mouth, heart, and feet. His message as he travels as a non profit is the renew and re-educate believers on the power of the blood and the importance to our daily walk in the faith.
