Some of these families have lost everything, no toys for the children, no furniture that is usable, no food, nothing to cook on or with. They are currently hauling in all they can to help these people survive. Viewers were invited to share from their blessings to help folks less fortunate know that someone cares about their plight.

Aired July 28, 2022

Chris James, Michael James, and Ezekiel Anderson shared on the program today about a recent mission trip to Albania. Each of them discussed an area in which they grew through this experience with Global Adventures and John Smithwick. People were healed, lost persons were saved and the individuals who went are excited to go again in the future. Global Adventures is a non-profit organization that offers opportunities for lay persons to go on short term missionary trips.

Aired August 9, 2022

Horace and Judy Carney were 2 of the guests today. The segment where they were featured was about the Marriage conference coming up in Sept. 9-11th here locally. The Conference is entitled "Weekend to Remember" and it provides couples an opportunity to get away and focus on refreshing their relationship while acquiring or enhancing their skills and resources to strengthen their marriage.

Aired August 23, 2022

Pastor Jimmy Murray and Eddie B joined the program today with updates on ministry in their areas. Jimmy is local and provides food, clothing, outreach to include cooked meals to homeless and persons in poverty in the inner city. Eddie has an active prison ministry in New Mexico. Having been in prison himself, he now ministers and disciples inmates to live for Jesus. He is an accomplished musician and singer/songwriter. He is a traveling evangelist, sharing the gospel wherever and whenever he has the opportunity.

Kimberly McDonald-Walden shared the program with a local pastor, sharing during the second segment about the GLM2 Foundation and their fundraiser coming up on October 1, 2022.
