THE SHOWS BRINGS ATTENTION TO NEWS EVENTS AND THE SOCIETAL AND POLITICAL ISSUES OF THE DAY.

TOPICS OF PUBLIC INTEREST COVERED BY KUBE - RICHARD FRENCH LIVE PROGRAMMING INCLUDE (BUT NOT LIMITED TO):

- ECONOMIC AND CIVIC AFFAIRS: All aspects affecting the life of the communities, the status of the economy and the broader civic affairs spectrum of issues including racism, bias, inequality, worker rights, jobs/employment, and police conduct. *This quarter attention was given to the economy of the U.K., devastation from Hurricane Ian, correlation between inequality and crime, the national debt and state of the U.S. economy, U.S. supply chain problems, Racial Justice, OPEC cutting oil production and effect on gas prices and economy, discussion of factors contributing to the erosion of the Middle Class, state of factory and manufacturing jobs in the U.S., inflation and rising interest rates, discussion on if U.S. oil independence could really stop rising gas prices, bringing manufacturing jobs back to the U.S., discussion on labor unions and if they are growing in popularity, Elon Musk buying Twitter and mayhem that followed, contributing factors to rising inflation in the U.S., high interest rates effect on the housing market, potential for the resurgence of the middle class, President Biden's Broadband Plan, Biden extending temporary student loan repayment relief through August 2023, update on the economy and potential for housing crisis, gas prices slowly going down, discussion on Dems handling of the impending rail strike, discussion on antisemitism including Kanye West's outburst, and Trump's dinner with Nick Fuentes, update on living conditions in the Ukraine and the people's resolve, discussion on the Federal Minimum Wage which hasn't been raised since 2009, potential effect of the rise of Unions on the minimum wage, Ohio Sen. Sherrod Brown on the rise of cutting edge factories in Ohio creating family sustaining jobs, big corporations push to restore Trump era tax breaks, update on the economy and U.S. inflation, discussion on internet privacy and net neutrality, resurgence of blue collar jobs, state of manufacturing jobs heading into 2023, discussion on how to determine what's truth and what's misinformation in news/media.*
