

WJDK 95.7 FM Quarterly Issues

June – September 2017

1. June 22nd WJDK reported on the murder of 10-day-old child that occurred in Marseilles. Jeffrey Price was arrested for alleged crime and remains in the LaSalle County Jail.
2. June 27th WJDK informed the public that a Grundy County man with seven prior DUI convictions was sentenced to 14 years in prison. We interviewed Grundy County State's Attorney Jason Helland about the plea agreement.
3. July 5th WJDK notified the public regarding a plea agreement of an Aurora man that was involved in one of the biggest drug busts in Grundy County's history.
4. July 20th WJDK reported that Morris Hospital would be leasing office space in the former Shabbona School building. We interviewed Morris District 54 Superintendent Shannon Dudek and Janet Long from Morris Hospital.
5. August 1st WJDK launched a new online daily newspaper that gives readers and listeners breaking local news, sports, obituaries and more. The website is wcsjnews.com.
6. August 7th WJDK reported that an 18-year-old Morris man was arrested for DUI after getting into a crash that injured a family of four. We interviewed Grundy County Sheriff Kevin Callahan about the incident.
7. August 18th WJDK reported on a teenager that was arrested for allegedly beating a family member to death in early March.
8. August 28th WJDK informed the public that the state of Illinois allocated money to clean up the former Aqueduct along the I&M Canal Towpath.
9. August 28th WJDK also informed the public about the possibility of two solar farms coming to Grundy County. We interviewed Land Use Director Heidi Miller about the topic.
10. September 6th WJDK reported that the Morris City Council approved an ordinance that allows the VFW to continue their Queen of Hearts game which was suspended in August. WJDK interviewed Mayor Dick Kopczick and representatives from the VFW.
