- Growing up as an only child, Gina Lozada of Long Island always wanted a sibling. Yet after her father died, Gina's mom revealed a family secret -- that her dad had fathered a son with another woman before they were married. For almost three decades Gina ran into dead-ends while searching for her brother, but she never gave up hope. Will a strange encounter with a New Jersey man at an Atlantic City casino be the turning point for Gina in her life-long quest to find her sibling?
- Mississippi native Amanda Holdiness, 31, has always wanted to meet her biological father. The only problem is her mother, Vivian, refused to reveal his true identity saying she was all Amanda ever needed. Vivian finally gave Amanda a name last year, and, after watching "20/20" and Slaton solve another case, she turned to Slaton to help find him. They traveled to Florida and Louisiana. Will it prove to be successful journeys?

It is a story that first gripped the country last year when a series of bizarre and tragic coincidences led to a deadly shootout, leaving Tammy Myers, a mother of four, dead in her Las Vegas cul-de-sac after giving her 15-year-old daughter a driving lesson. Was it the result of road rage as initially reported, or something else? Deborah Roberts' reports.

WHAT THE CAMERA DIDN'T SEE

Nique Leili was found dead near her suburban home a week after going missing. Her family immediately suspected husband Matt, who filed for divorce within days of her disappearance. He claimed Nique was "crazy" and that she stormed off. Matt, who had installed 21 cameras and other surveillance devices in his home to keep watch on the spouse he did not trust, refused to help police. It took nearly four years for prosecutors to determine there was enough evidence to charge Matt and take the case to trial. Jim Avila reports.

MYSTERY IN APT. 410

It is a Southern California mystery ripped straight from a Hollywood script, yet the actors in this drama are real, and so are the twists and turns that unfold in solving a double murder. The plot involves a community theater actor, Daniel Wozniak, who tries to frame a dedicated Afghanistan war veteran, Sam Herr, for the murder of a 23-year-old dancer and college student, Juri "Julie" Kibuishi, 23. Julie is found dead in the apartment of her good friend, Sam, whom she tutored. Jim Avila reports.

BREAKING POINT: HEROIN IN AMERICA

The rate of opioid overdoses has tripled since 2000. In fact, more than 100 Americans die every day from drug overdoses – more people than gunshot wounds or car accidents. ABC News announces takes viewers beyond those statistics with an unvarnished report on several families struggling with heroin addiction and the lack of help. In one family a young husband and wife start rehab with startlingly different results. In another family, ABC News explores the rising incidence of mothers and their newborn babies both dependent on heroin. David Muir reports.
