PERSPECTIVA NACIONAL FCC REPORT – 2ND QUARTER 2017

ISSUE: NATIONAL POLITICS

Program: Perspectiva Nacional (Segment #1, 9:00)

When: April 2nd, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We interviewed Nevada Democrat representative Ruben Kihuen on the future of Obamacare if the law is not reformed as required, the growing Russian scandal, the impact on Hispanics if Neil Gorsuch is confirmed to the Supreme Court of Justice and the need for Devin Nunes, chairman of the House Intelligence Committee, to recuse himself from the Russia investigation after compromising his impartiality by sharing information with the White House before handing it over to committee members.

When: April 2nd, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

The LGBTQ community expresses concern that the advances for protecting their rights would be undermined during the administration of President Donald Trump. We interviewed Estrella Sánchez, a transgender activist.

When: April 16th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

After the missile attack on an air base in Syria, the relationship between the United States and Russia is tenser than ever. We interview political analyst Emilio Viano about the implications of this attack for the United States and its relationship with countries such as North Korea, Japan, China, among others.

Description of Program

We talk about the swearing in of Judge Neil Gorsuch as the new Supreme Court magistrate. Gorsuch is occupying the vacant seat left by the late Judge Antonin Scalia. We interview attorney Joseph Malouf about the impact that the new judge could have on issues that correspond to the Hispanic and immigrant community.

Description of Program

We analyze the tense relationship between the United States and North Korea and the possibilities of a nuclear war. We interview Louis Caldera, former Secretary of the Army and Carlos Castello, expert on international security issues at the Atlantic Council.

When: April 30th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We include a story about the continued resolution passed by Congress to temporarily prevent the shutdown of the federal government. We also make an assessment of the achievements and failures of President Donald Trump's first 100 days. We interviewed Democrat Analyst Vanessa Cárdenas and Republican Analyst Luis Quiñonez.

Program: Perspectiva Nacional (Segment #1, 9:00)

When: May 7th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We analyze the most recent political events. The House of Representatives voted and passed its proposal to revoke and replace Obamacare. In addition, Congress approved the federal budget to keep the government running until September and Hillary Clinton reappeared and blames James Comey, the FBI director and WikiLeaks for her defeat. We interviewed Federico De Jesús, a Democratic analyst and Wadi Gaitan, a Conservative spokesman for La Libre Iniciativa.

When: May 14th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We analyze the dismissal of FBI Director James Comey right in the middle of the investigation of Russian intrusion into the last election and the possible links between officials of President Donald Trump and Vladimir Putin. According to Trump, Initially the dismissal was for Comey's handling of Hillary Clinton's e-mail investigation, but the argument was met with skepticism. We interviewed Melissa Diaz, a Democratic analyst, and Israel Ortega, a Republican analyst.

When: May 21st, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We analyze the most recent scandals of the presidency of Donald Trump. This includes the leaking of a memorandum allegedly shared by James Comey in which the former FBI agent claims that Trump suggested he close the investigation against Michael Flynn. In addition, Robert Muller was named as the new person in charge of the investigation into the Russian connection in the 2016 elections. Also, the President shared confidential information with the Russian chancellor and ambassador on the war against terrorism. We interview California Democratic Congressman, Lou Correa and Texas Democratic Congressman, Vicente González.

Description of Program

Analyst evaluate President Donald Trump's trip to Saudi Arabia, Israel, the Vatican and his participation in the NATO summit meeting in Brussels, Belgium and G7 summit meeting in Sicily, Italy. We interviewed Dina Siegel Vann, Director of Latin and Latin American Affairs of the Jewish American Committee and Emilio Viano, International Affairs Analyst.

When: May 28th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We addressed the most recent events surrounding the Russian connection to presidential elections: The revelation that the President asked 2 senior intelligence chiefs to publicly deny the links of his campaign

with Russia, the testimony of John Brennan, former director Of the CIA, before the House Intelligence Committee. We also talked about the budget for fiscal year 2018. We interviewed Republican analyst Alfonso Aguilar and the spokesman for the Center for American Progress, Rafael Medina.

When: June 4th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We analyze the most recent scandals of the presidency of Donald Trump. This includes the ongoing investigation into possible Russian interference in the elections and the constant change of personnel in the White House. We also talk about what will happen when former FBI director James Comey testifies before the Senate. Will he confirm that President Trump asked him to terminate the investigation into possible links of officials of his campaign with Russia? We interview democratic analyst Fernando Treviño and Luis Quiñonez, a member of the Trump Administration.

Description of Program

We added a PKG on alleged bets in the UK where the public is betting on Trump's future as presidency.

When: June 11th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We analyze the testimony of former FBI director James Comey before the Senate Intelligence Committee. Comey said that President Trump asked for loyalty and suggested that he abandon the investigation of possible Russian interference in the presidential elections. In addition, we address the issue of a potential political judgment and the constant comparison of this scandal with "Watergate". We interview Democratic analyst Jorge Silva and Republican analyst Adolfo Franco.

Description of Program

We address the unprecedented shooting of Republican congressmen practicing baseball in a park in Alexandria, Virginia, for a charitable annual game against democrats. The third of the Republican leadership of the House of Representatives, Steve Scalise, was seriously injured, as well as 4 others. We also talk about the hearing before the Senate Intelligence Committee of Attorney General Jeff Sessions and about the expanding investigation of President Donald Trump regarding possible obstruction of justice in the case of Russian interfering in the 2016 elections. Guests: Stan Veuger, Researcher at the "American Enterprise Institute" and Jose Aristimuño, a Democratic analyst.

Description of Program

We talk about the plebiscite in Puerto Rico to define the political relationship of the Caribbean island with the United States. The governor of Puerto Rico, Ricardo Rosselló traveled to the nation's capital to deliver the results of the referendum that favored statehood. Guest: Federico de Jesús, political analyst.

We also talked about the implications of the elections in Georgia and South Carolina where Democrats were defeated and we also tackled tensions between the United States and Russia after a US fighter plane shot down an Iranian-made drone operated by forces supporting Syrian government. The American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations (AFL-CIO), released a report that reveals that Latino and immigrant workers continue to be at increased risk of dying on the job, since Hispanics perform the hardest and most dangerous jobs in the United States. We interviewed Richard Trumka, AFI-CIO's President.

When: April 9th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

April is the month of awareness against Sexual Abuse. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the majority of the victims are women, but the most disturbing statistics are men and boys of all ages. Sexologist Claudia Campos talks about the lack of information that exists in our community, what to do to avoid an assault and the need for victims to request professional help to deal with the trauma.

We talked about "Trumpcare". The House of Representatives passed a measure to repeal and replace the Affordable Care Act, but it has yet to pass through the Senate and other legislative processes. Will they be able to revoke Obamacare? We interviewed Leonardo Cuello, Director Health Policy's Director of the National Health Law Program. We also included a story where we showed how upset some voters reacted

during the town hall meetings held by some Republican congressmen who voted in favor of the so-called "Trumpcare".

Description of Program

We talk about the opposition from the public, according to a survey by the Kaiser Family Foundation, toward the efforts of the House of Representatives to revoke and replace Obamacare. After a victory in the House, a report from the Congressional Budget Office of the United States, a nonpartisan organization, revealed that the second version of Trumpcare would leave 23 million people out of coverage over the next 10 years. Now the bill passes to the Senate where, even members of the Republican, have indicated their disagreement with Trumpcare. We interview Annette Raveneau of Families USA.

Description of Program

Program: Perspectiva Nacional (Segment #2 8:00)

When: April 2nd, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We address Attorney General Jeff Sessions' threats to withdraw federal funds from cities that refuse to collaborate with ICE. We are also talk about the new "rise up" campaign launched by Hispanic organizations to combat anti-immigrant measures. Sulma Arias spokesperson with FIRM talked to Tsi-tsi-ki Felix.

Program: Perspectiva Nacional (Segment #1 8:59)

When: April 9th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We interviewed Representative Henry Cuellar (D-Texas) about this week's meeting between the Congressional Hispanic Caucus and Secretary of Homeland Security John Kelly. The lawmakers claimed some ICE abuses and excesses against the immigrant community since the new administration began. The congressman also talks about the construction of the wall in the border with Mexico, as well the importance of maintaining NAFTA.

Description of Program

We address the issue of immigration. We also address the issue of increased raids and Attorney General Jeff Sessions' call for federal prosecutors to give priority to cases of undocumented immigrants.

Description of Program

Salvatrucha” gang-affiliated members. We also talk about Sessions' allegations that "sanctuary cities" prevent them from fighting criminal organizations.

Description of Program

We address the issue of immigration. On September 1, SB4 Law, signed by Texas Governor Greg Abbott, comes into force. This legislation prohibits sanctuary cities in that state. Critics of the law indicate that it encourages racial discrimination while civil rights advocates seek to revoke it in the courts. We also talked about the future of the Temporary Protected Status for Haitians, Salvadorans, Hondurans and Nicaraguans. We interviewed Immigration attorney José Pertierra.

Description of Program

We talk about farm workers. According to the Department of Agriculture, 70% of all agricultural workers are undocumented. Legislators in Congress have introduced a bill that seeks to improve the opportunities, benefits and safety of these workers. We interview Adrienne Dervartanian, Immigration and Labor Rights Director of "Farmworker Justice" and Iván Yacub, immigration lawyer.

When: May 28th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We tell the story of Mrs. Veronica Castro, who despite being married to a US veteran and having four children born in this country (one of them with special needs), runs the risk of being deported in accordance with the new migratory policies of President Donald Trump. We interviewed the immigration lawyer, Simón Sandoval, who also told us about the future of TPS for Salvadorans, Hondurans and Nicaraguans, after the Department of Homeland Security extended this benefit to the Haitians, for only 6 months. We also addressed the issue of sanctuary cities.

When: June 11th, 2017 (Saturday 11:00pm/Sunday 6:00pm)

Description of Program

We talk about the future of TPS. The uncertainty grows among Central Americans, beneficiaries of the program known as Temporary Protection Status, after the protection was extended to Haitians for only 6 months. Abel Nuñez, executive director of "Carecen" and José Pertierra, an immigration attorney, explain the implications it would have if the TPS is cancelled.

Description of Program

We continue talking with Abel Nuñez, Executive Director of Carecen and José Pertierra, immigration attorney, about the TPS and the options that exist for the beneficiaries and the U.S. government. We also talk about the political and economic impact that this possible revocation would have for the Central American countries.
