The following long-term recruitment initiatives were implemented by the Virgin Islands Public Broadcasting System during this reporting period:

A. Internship/Student Programs:

The System provided learning opportunities for four (4) students within the following internship programs.

- Summer Employee Program During the summer of 2023, two students participated in the Legislature's Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) through the Offices of Senators Franklin D. Johnson and Dwayne M. DeGraff. This gave the students the opportunity to learn skills contributing to their interested career path in the Radio and Production Departments out of the St. Croix facility. The students were engaged for 30 hours each week for a period of six weeks.
- 2. Student Shadowing/Internship During this reporting period, the System partnered with the Department of Human Services, Division of Disabilities and Vocational Rehabilitation Services to entertain one student with real–world work experience. WTJX served as a worksite to allow this student to explore his potential in a supportive employment setting. The System also hosted a Hampton University Junior, majoring in Strategic Communications with an Emphasis in Audio Production. The student completed an 8-hour shadowing tour to gain first-hand observatory knowledge of professionals in the work-setting. The intern was able to shadow the Senior Producer to gain insights into the day-to-day and behind-the-scenes practices of the role.

B. Career and Recruitment Fairs:

WTJX participated in eight Career Fairs through its Human Resources Division which provided for the dissemination of employment opportunities within the System to a diverse group of potential candidates within the community. Below is a listing of these events, four of which were held on the island of St. Thomas and four on the island of St. Croix:

Department of Labor Career Fair: January 11, 2023 (St. Croix) and January 18, 2023 (St. Thomas)

University of the Virgin Islands Career and Recruitment Fair: March 29, 2023 (St. Croix) and March 30, 2023 (St. Thomas)

Department of Labor Career Fair: May 3, 2023 (St. Thomas) and May 10, 2023 (St. Croix)

Department of Labor in Collaboration with the Division of Personnel Career Fair: September 13, 2023 (St. Thomas) and September 20, 2023 (St. Croix)

C. Career Development Training:

As part of our commitment to maintaining a prepared workforce, the Virgin Islands Public Broadcasting System strongly encourages employees to obtain training and complete professional development courses. In so doing, employees will enhance their organizational knowledge and skills to optimize performance, and ultimately advance the successes of the System. Some areas of trainings completed during the reporting period include the following:

Project Management Course – This one-month course was attended by the Facilities Coordinator on St. Croix from January to February 2023. The course provided the opportunity to learn about managing projects and staying abreast of current strategies for meeting project deadlines efficiently. The course gave guidance and offered an in-depth understanding of the processes and requirements for managing projects.

Public Media Summit (2023) – This Summit was attended by the Chief Executive Officer and Vice Chair of the Governing Board in February/March 2023. The gathering of public broadcasting general managers and community leaders allows for collaboration and exploration of issues that are vital to the future and mission of public service media.

National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) Show 2023 Conference – The annual NAB trade show conference was attended by the Assistant Director of Engineering, Production Manager, and Director of New Media in April 2023. The NAB Show was a major source of obtaining a wealth of information and opportunities for growth in all areas of the modern broadcasting industry.

Public Broadcasting System Annual Conference and General Managers' Meeting – This Conference and Meeting was attended by the Chief Executive Officer and Programming Manager in May 2023. The General Managers' Meeting provided the opportunity for top executives and major stakeholders to discuss current public media issues relative to the public service mission.

Public Media Business Association (PMBA) Annual Conference - This hybrid conference was attended by the Chief Financial Officer and Senior Financial Officer in May/June 2023. Attendance at the conference provided the opportunity to gain a broader range of knowledge needed to perform duties in financial reporting to include Annual Financial Reports, TV and Radio Community Service Grant Review, audits, required compliance, and guidelines.

Public Media Development & Marketing Conference (PMDMC) - The Board of Directors Chairman and the Chief Executive Officer attended this annual conference in July 2023. The conference provided public media leaders access to valuable strategic steps designed to increase untapped or under-explored revenue. In addition, this conference provided actionable ideas and strategies that are meant to immediately drive more revenue for the station. By attending the PMDMC, the Chairman of the Board and CEO were able to connect and gain insight from other system professionals who are tackling the same industry issues.

Human Resources Seminars/Webinars – Throughout the year, the Human Resources Director participated in quarterly trainings provided by the Government's Division of Personnel designed to ensure that HR professionals are informed of current regulations and processes, along with any updates, necessary for success in the industry. The Human Resources Director also participated in the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) and Department of Labor Virtual Webinar on Advancing Equality for Women in the Workplace, which heightened awareness on new protections under the Fair Labor Standards Act for nursing mothers in the workplace, and the requirements of the newly introduced Pregnant Workers Fairness Act. Additionally, the HR Director attended the webinar "Disability is Part of the Equity Equation" which highlighted how individuals with various disabilities can be effectively incorporated into the workplace in support of equity and inclusion.

D. All Employee Trainings:

Preventing Harassment and Discrimination Training – This is a mandatory annual training requirement which was issued in April 2023 to all employees and managers with a completion due date of June 30, 2023. The Harassment and Discrimination Prevention Training is designed to build awareness about professional behaviors in the workplace and define boundaries for a non-discriminatory and harassment-free environment.

Diversity, Inclusion and Belonging Training – This training was issued in July 2023 to all employees, managers, and Board Members. The deadline for completing the required annual training was September 15, 2023. The training is designed to provide information and examples for a better understanding of valuing individual differences and demonstrating sensitivity to diversity, equity, and inclusion in the workplace.

E. Participation in Job Banks and Internet Programs

The System listed all vacant positions on the Virgin Islands Public Broadcasting System website and on Department of Labor (DOL) job listing system. The DOL administers a system of effective programs and services designed to develop, protect, and maintain a viable workforce in the community of the Virgin Islands. The System also actively recruited through the Indeed platform which proved to be the most effective source in recruiting qualified individuals. Additionally, through participation in national public media job listings, the System has an opportunity to disseminate vacancy notices to a wide range of applicants in the broadcasting industry.
