NEWS CHANNEL 12 AT FIVE

Premiering Monday, April 13, 1992, NewsChannel 12 News At 5 offers headlines of the day and entertainment news with Anchors Wes Goforth and Valentina Wilson, weather with Meteorologist Skip Waters, and sports with Brian North. The format of the program is lighter than the 6:00 PM newscast, but still offers the day's top news. The 5 PM newscast began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first 5PM newscast in the market in HD.

The program is a local entity, having been on the air now for over 40 years, and satisfies the requirements for the Children's Television Act, as it has since its inception. The program is edited for a maximum of 4:00 available commercial inventory for the 30-minute time period, and is generally filled with public service and promotional announcements.
