CONTINUOUS COVERAGE OF HURRICANE IRENE

WCTI provided continuous coverage of Hurricane Irene from 9:30 AM Friday, August 26 through Midnight Sunday, August 28, 2011. Even though thousands in the area were without power, the stations provided complete coverage through back-up power at the station, and a simulcast with area radio stations to keep residents informed of the various circumstances associated with the storm, both during and following the storm during recovery efforts. Details follow in various issues covered.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

The following programs are not broadcast within the core programming time period, and will not be considered as part of WCTI's children's core programs. However, because of the content and educational purpose of the programs, we submit them as part of this report to show good intent.

TELESTORY TIME

Hosted by local librarian Miss Elinor Hawkins, the program is specifically designed for children 2--11 years of age. Each week, Miss Elinor reads several story books that deal with basic moral and ethical qualities desirable in young children. The program is a local entity, having been on the air now for over 40 years, and satisfies the requirements for the Children's Television Act, as it has since its inception. The program is edited for a maximum of 4:00 available commercial inventory for the 30-minute time period, and is generally filled with public service and promotional announcements.
