#### **HURRICANE SANDY COVERAGE**

The weekend of Oct. 27, 2012, Hurricane Sandy was passing just off the coast of Eastern North Carolina, posing potential threats and danger to our area. The WCTI News Team provided full news and weather coverage with regular cut-ins and updates throughout the day on Saturday, Oct. 27 and during the morning and afternoon of Sunday, Oct. 28 until the major impact passed out of the area.

#### **CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING**

The following programs are not broadcast within the core programming time period, and will not be considered as part of WCTI's children's core programs. However, because of the content and educational purpose of the programs, we submit them as part of this report to show good intent.

#### **TELESTORY TIME**

Hosted by local librarian Miss Elinor Hawkins, the program is specifically designed for children 2--11 years of age. Each week, Miss Elinor reads several story books that deal with basic moral and ethical qualities desirable in young children. The program is a local entity, having been on the air now for over 40 years, and satisfies the requirements for the Children's Television Act, as it has since its inception. The program is edited for a maximum of 4:00 available commercial inventory for the 30-minute time period, and is generally filled with public service and promotional announcements.
