However, 5 million of that total were received in August 2011 because of Hurricane Irene.

CYSTIC FIBROSIS TELETHON

The 35th Annual Cystic Fibrosis Telethon was held Saturday, August 11 and raised \$410,448 for research for cystic fibrosis, the nation's leading genetic cause of death for children and young adults. In an effort to concentrate on prime fund-raising time, the broadcast was shortened to air five and a half hours, from 6:30 PM – Midnight. Hosted by the NewsChannel 12 news anchors, the telethon showcased over 20 performers from throughout Eastern North Carolina.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

The following programs are not broadcast within the core programming time period, and will not be considered as part of WCTI's children's core programs. However, because of the content and educational purpose of the programs, we submit them as part of this report to show good intent.

TELESTORY TIME

Hosted by local librarian Miss Elinor Hawkins, the program is specifically designed for children 2--11 years of age. Each week, Miss Elinor reads several story books that deal with basic moral and ethical qualities desirable in young children. The program is a local entity, having been on the air now for over 40 years, and satisfies the requirements for the Children's Television Act, as it has since its inception. The program is edited for a maximum of 4:00 available commercial inventory for the 30-minute time period, and is generally filled with public service and promotional announcements.
