



LOCAL AND SYNDICATED PROGRAMMING

GOOD MORNING EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA

The first locally-produced, early morning news program in the market, GOOD MORNING EASTERN NORTH CAROLINA, is hosted by Anna Bulszewicz along with Meteorologist Les Still. The show provides 120 minutes of overnight local and national news, sports weather, financial and agri-business updates, as well as regional feature reports about the people, places and events of interest. GMENC began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first morning newscast in the market in HD.

Broadcast: Monday—Friday 5:00 -- 7:00 AM

DR. OZ

Beginning September 14, 2009 Dr. Mehmet Oz joined the lineup with a multi-topic, multi-segment health and wellness show offering topical, newsworthy information and inspiring stories in an upbeat and entertaining hour that features Dr. Oz's unique point of view and experts in various fields.

Broadcast: Mon. through Fri 4:00 – 5:00 PM

NEWS CHANNEL 12 AT NOON

Anchor Anna Bulszewicz along with Meteorologist Les Still provide current news, weather and sports. A regular major feature of the program, Family Health Watch, provides news and information of medical concerns.

The Noon newscast began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first noon newscast in the market in HD.

Broadcast: Monday through Friday 12:00--12:30 PM

NEWS CHANNEL 12 AT FIVE

Premiering Monday, April 13, 1992, NewsChannel 12 News At 5 offers headlines of the day and entertainment news with Anchors Wes Goforth and Valentina Wilson, and weather with Chief Meteorologist Skip Waters. The format of the program is lighter than the 6:00 PM newscast, but still offers the day's top news. The 5 PM newscast began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first 5PM newscast in the market in HD.

Broadcast: Monday through Friday 5:00--5:30 PM

NEWS CHANNEL 12 AT 5:30 PM

Effective August 15, 2011 WCTI added another 30 minutes of news at 5:30 PM, creating a two-hour news block 5:00 – 7:00 PM, ending with ABC World News Tonight. The program features Brian North and Jaime McCutcheon as anchors and provides an opportunity to bring more in-depth stories and additional headlines to viewers.

Broadcast: Monday through Friday 5:30 – 6:00 PM

NEWS CHANNEL 12 AT SIX

NewsChannel 12 News At 6 provides the latest-breaking news, sports and weather, headed by Co-anchors Wes Goforth and Valentina Wilson, and Chief Meteorologist Skip Waters. The 6 PM newscast began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first 6PM newscast in the market in HD.

Broadcast: Monday through Friday 6:00--6:30 PM

NEWS CHANNEL 12 NEWS AT ELEVEN

Anchors Wes Goforth and Valentina Wilson lead the news team in presenting viewers with the latest updates of the day's news events. Meteorologist Skip Waters re-caps the day's weather and presents the outlook for the morning.

The 11 PM newscast began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first 11PM newscast in the market in HD.

NEWS CHANNEL 12 AT SIX AND ELEVEN WEEKEND EDITION

Weekend Anchor Jon Erickson and Meteorologist Ellen Bacca provide updates on local weekend news of the area, the weather outlook for planning outdoor activities and weekend sports highlights. WCTI debuted local news in high definition with the 6PM news Sunday, June 27, 2010. Ellen was awarded the National Weather Association Television Broadcaster's seal of approval in June 2013.

GOOD MORNING EASTERN CAROLINA WEEKEND

Beginning Saturday, September 4, 2004 Good Morning Eastern Carolina expanded to seven days a week. Anchor Kyle Horan and Meteorologist Jonathan Weant get viewers up to date on the latest news, upcoming weekend events and what the weather holds in store for weekend activities.
Broadcast: Saturday and Sunday 7:00 – 8:00 AM

FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH

Designed to give viewers an actual church service on Sunday morning, the program is locally produced by WCTI as a service to the community. The church service is taped weekly at First Baptist Church in New Bern, then edited to a 30-minute program for air the following Sunday morning. The program accomplishes the teaching of religious values in a local setting that is easily recognized and appreciated by viewers.
Broadcast: Sunday 11:00--11:30 AM

MISSING

Hoping to reunite families with their loved ones, "Missing" serves an important and invaluable community service by offering safety tips and real-life stories to help find missing persons. In cooperation with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the show builds awareness about the serious and widespread problem of missing individuals, especially children. To date, over 672 persons featured on "Missing" have been found.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

The following programs are not broadcast within the core programming time period, and will not be considered as part of WCTI's children's core programs. However, because of the content and educational purpose of the programs, we submit them as part of this report to show good intent.

TELESTORY TIME

Hosted by local librarian Miss Elinor Hawkins, the program is specifically designed for children 2--11 years of age. Each week, Miss Elinor reads several story books that deal with basic moral and ethical qualities desirable in young children. The program is a local entity, having been on the air now for 50 years, and satisfies the requirements for the Children's Television Act, as it has since its inception. The program is edited for a maximum of 4:00 available commercial inventory for the 30-minute time period, and is generally filled with public service and promotional announcements.

Broadcast: Saturday 6:00--6:30 AM.
