GMENC began broadcasting in high definition Monday, June 27, 2010 as the first morning newscast in the market in HD.

#### **CYSTIC FIBROSIS TELETHON**

The 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Cystic Fibrosis Telethon aired Saturday, August 10, 2013 from 6:30 PM – Midnight live from the Family Life Center of First Baptist Church in Downtown New Bern. Hosted by the NewsChannel 12 News Team, the telethon featured over 20 performers from throughout Eastern North Carolina and raised a record \$412,835 to provide research for Cystic Fibrosis, the nation's leading genetic killer of children and young adults.

The program is a local entity, having been on the air now for over 40 years, and satisfies the requirements for the Children's Television Act, as it has since its inception. The program is edited for a maximum of 4:00 available commercial inventory for the 30-minute time period, and is generally filled with public service and promotional announcements.
