GUESTS ARE LINED UP THROUGH THE KANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY EXTENSION OFFICE. THE PROGRAM LASTS APPROXIMATELY 3 MINUTES. GUEST LIST IS CARLA NEMACEK, ALLEN COUNTY EXTENSION AGENT ON AG, KATHY MC EWAN, ALLEN CO. FACS AGENT, AND DOUG PEINE, FARM SERVICE AGENCY ON A ROTATING BASIS.

ANIMAL TRACKS

ANIMAL CONTROL IS AN IMPORTANT ISSUES IN IOLA WITH ABOUT 1,000 STRAY ANIMALS BEING PICKED UP THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THE IOLA POLICE DEPARTMENT PROVIDES US WITH DAILY INFORMATION ABOUT THE STRAY ANIMALS THAT HAVE BEEN PICKED UP SO OWNERS CAN CLAIM THEIR PETS BEFORE THEY ARE DESTROYED. INFORMATION IS ALSO RECEIVED FROM CHANUTE, HUMBOLDT AND OTHER AREA TOWNS. THE PROGRAM IS APPROXIMATELY 2 MINUTES IN LENGTH AND AIRS DAILY MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY AT 8:50AM.

AIRING EVERY SUNDAY AT 6:30AM, VIEWPOINTS IS 28-MINUTE RADIO MAGAZINE THAT DEALS WITH TWO MAJOR ISSUES EACH WEEK, GIVING THE AUDIENCE NEWS THEY CAN USE. THE SHOW DEALS WITH TOPICS SUCH AS: Crime Environment Housing Schools Poverty Taxes Economic development Urban sprawl Consumerism

"TRADING POST" SHOW

EVERY MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY FROM 8:05 TO 9:00 AM, KIKS AND KIOI BROADCAST THE TRADING POST PROGRAM, WHICH IS LIKE A COMMUNITY BULLETIN BOARD. IN ADDITION TO LETTING LISTENERS BUY, SELL AND TRADE THEIR ITEMS, THEY ARE ENCOURAGED TO PASS ALONG COMMUNITY ITEMS. COMMUNITY GROUPS OFTEN CALL WITH ANNOUNCEMENTS ON ACTIVITIES, PEOPLE IN NEED (SUCH AS FIRE LOSS, HEALTH PROBLEMS) ARE CALLED IN FOR ASSISTANCE, LOST PETS AND ITEMS ARE REPORTED, ETC. PLUS, WE READ 4-5 PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS PER PROGRAM.

DATES BROADCAST: DAILY MONDAY-FRIDAYS EXCEPT HOLIDAYS

LOCALLY PRODUCED NEWSCASTS

ISSUES ARE ALSO DEALT WITH ON A REGULAR BASIS ON OUR LOCALLY PRODUCED NEWSCASTS. NEWSCASTS AIR FIVE TIMES EACH MORNING MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY AND AT NOON MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. 1 MINUTE IN LENGTH.

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS ARE PROVIDED FREE OF CHARGE TO NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, CLUBS, SCHOOLS, CHURCHS, MUNICIPALITIES AND INDIVIDUALS. KIKS-FM AND KIOL-AM ACTIVELY SEEK OUT THESE ANNOUNCEMENTS BY BROADCASTING A MESSAGE THAT ENCOURAGES THOSE INTERESTED IN PUBLICITY FOR THEIR EVENT TO SEND US INFORMATION THAT WE CAN THEN BROADCAST. WE PROVIDE THREE WAYS TO GET THEM TO US....BY FAX, BY E-MAIL AND BY REGULAR MAIL. THE PSA SOLICITATION IS AIRED THREE TIMES DAILY ON EACH STATION AND WE READ ONE PSA PER HOUR...SOMETIMES MORE. USUALLY THERE ARE AT LEAST 4 DURING OUR "TRADING POST" HOUR WHICH IS SIMULCAST ON KIKS AND KIOL.

NEWS AND WEATHER INFORMATION PROVIDED ON KIKS-FM & KIOL

KIKS-FM 101.5 RUNS FOX NEWS AT THE TOP OF THE HOUR AT 4AM to 7PM WEEKDAYS AND 4AM TO 9AM WEEKENDS.

KIOL-AM 1370 RUNS FOX NEWS AT THE TOP OF EVERY HOUR (EXCEPT DURING SPORTS BROADCASTS).
BOTH STATIONS CARRY THE FOX 5-MINUTE NEWS SERVICE.

IN ADDITION, KIOL-AM 1370 CARRIES KANSAS INFORMATION NETWORK NEWS. THE FULL 2-MINUTE NEWSCAST AIRS AT 6:30AM, 7:30AM, 11:30AM, 12:30PM, 1:30PM, 3:30PM, & 4:30PM. THE "NEWS IN A MINUTE" AIRS 3 MINUTES PAST THE HOUR AT 9AM, 10AM, 11AM, 2PM, 3PM, 4PM & 6PM.

KIKS-FM CARRIES "NEWS IN A MINUTE" AT 6, 7 AND 8AM.

WEATHER INFORMATION

WEATHER INFORMATION IS PROVIDED A MINIMUM OF TWO TIMES AN HOUR ON BOTH KIKS & KIOL. THERE ARE MANY HOURS, SUCH AS IN THE MORNING, THAT WE PROVIDE WEATHER INFORMATION 3-4 TIMES AN HOUR. KIKS-KIOL STRIVES TO PROVIDE LIVE UP-TO-THE-MINUTE INFORMATION DURING BREAKING SEVERE WEATHER SITUATIONS ON A 24-HOUR BASIS.
