Section I - Issues

The stations have identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

<u>A. "SAFETY NET" HOSPITALS</u> – The rising cost of healthcare is a major concern of many families in southern Indiana and western Kentucky. Paying for healthcare services in our area's prominent hospitals and physician's offices is difficult for those in the Tri-State community that do not have employer-provided healthcare coverage. As a result, a number of private, low-cost clinics and medical facilities have been appearing, allowing access to healthcare that our less fortunate citizens could not afford otherwise.

B. FOOD MARKETING & OBESITY – An ongoing conversation in the Tristate area concerns our rising rates of obesity- which are tied directly to food habits and behavior. Although they have existed for a number of years, a local group called "Feed Evansville" is stepping up efforts to provide food education and working diligently to reduce the number of food deserts in Vanderburgh County. Similar organizations in southern Indiana and western Kentucky are following suit.

<u>C. PICKLEBALL & INJURIES</u> – The hottest recreational sport has arrived in the Tri-State with Evansville looking to build a pickleball complex to keep up with demand that's growing exponentially by the day. The River City Pickleball Club, based in Owensboro, KY, is also adding new players to its roster on the daily. Consequently, local health officials and physical trainers are warning that they are seeing an increase in injuries related to the sport and are offering tips to aid in the reduction of doctor's office and emergency visits.

<u>D: REWIRE YOUR BRAIN</u> – Though it's no longer considered an international health crisis, the long-term effects of the COVID-19 pandemic remain. A lot of bad habits resulting from the isolation during the pandemic are revealing themselves during routine physical and mental health checkups. Health officials in the Tristate are launching informational campaigns about how to rediscover and reclaim those pre-pandemic healthy habits.

<u>E. EDUCATIONAL DROPOUTS</u> – No, not the students. Teachers. According to a recent national survey, over onethird of teachers are considering leaving the profession and the educational systems in the Tri-State are no different. Various school systems in southern Indiana and western Kentucky have suffered a mass exodus of educators. Nearly every school district in our area is facing a teacher shortage and is desperately trying to find more qualified instructors to lead our classrooms.

F. CANNABIS & PROFIT – Recent changes in Tri-State laws have divided the citizens of our area about the prospect of bringing marijuana, hemp & CBD to the forefront and storefronts. The biggest challenge? A lack of consistency with state laws and that lack of consistency confuses both business owners and consumers. For example- Indiana currently only allows hemp & CBD products. Illinois has legalized marijuana completely. Kentucky only allows the sale and use of 'medical' marijuana.
