Issues of importance to the ALLEGANY & MINERAL COUNTIES area:

DRUGS/OPIOID EPIDEMIC – Although rural, Allegany & Mineral Counties have experienced a significant increase in drug activity especially in the area of Opioid overdoses and drug possession & distribution arrests. The tri-state area has been greatly impacted by the easy access to our area due to highway improvements and the location of prison facilities in our area. The location of the Federal and State prisons here is also causing concern that we are being impacted from a crime/gang perspective related to the drug activity.

ECONOMY/EMPLOYMENT – Like most small towns across the nation, the area is depressed due to lack of new business and job opportunities in general. Residents want to know about changing technology and opportunities for more jobs in our area.

EDUCATION – Always a major concern, in a period of time when new school construction is being developed, and testing on State and Federal levels seems to mount each year, residents are extremely concerned with the state of our local school system.

PUBLIC HEALTH – The area has a significantly high percentage of Senior citizens and low-income families, which precipitates higher incidences of health issues.

SENIOR CITIZENS/VETERANS – A large part of the population of the Cumberland/Allegany County/Keyser/Mineral county area is comprised of senior citizens, many of whom are veterans, and their concerns include health and medical care, living on a fixed income, transportation and housing as well as affording the continuing increase in the cost of living.

TOURISM –A composite of service and tourism related job opportunities is what has become of our economy in this area. Although new businesses are beginning to show interest in the area, the majority seem to be of the service industry to cater to travelers.
