Done in a coaching format, action-oriented style, listeners can call in using an anonymous name if preferred, identify a desired life change, and then collaboratively agree on a series of small, specific actions to help achieve their desired goal. The focus is personal change, not an attempt to change anyone else. No diagnosing, no advice giving, no judgment. The listener is encouraged to call, text, or chat back to report to the listening audience how things are going and then identify the next steps toward goal achievement. Once a month, Dr. Watson will interview the director of a local social service organization to describe available services and the best way to access help.
