Although, many low and moderate income workers may be eligible to receive up to \$6,557 if their 2019 income qualifies them for the earned income tax credit.

Narcan is the nasal spray version of Naloxone and can revive a person who overdoses in minutes. The suggested retail price is \$44.99 per box, which contains two doses.

Amoxicillin is only available with a prescription and doctors do not recommend taking it without visiting a specialist first. Always do what your health professional recommends and don't self-prescribe because that's when you end up with a lot of problems at hand.
