WRAL Investigative Documentary Producer Cristin Severance and WRAL Sports Anchor Chris Lea set out to uncover who these stadiums were named after, where they were built and what communities they displaced. Severance, Lea and WRAL Documentary Photojournalist Dwayne Meyers traveled throughout North and South Carolina and explored the history behind Kenan Stadium at UNC Chapel Hill, Carter-Finley Stadium at NC State, Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte, and Memorial Stadium at Clemson University. Stadiums are built to bring people together. While these four sports complexes exist on sites of violence against Black people, burial sites of the formerly enslaved, and Black communities displaced in the name of progress, there is opportunity in the unity of sports to celebrate the citizens forgotten by the existence of these massive structures.
