Recruitment for Full-Time Vacancies

As reflected in the annual public file reports for August 2011 to July 2012 submitted heretofore, the Stations have engaged in recruitment for their full-time vacancies and have widely disseminated information concerning these vacancies, including to recruiting organizations reasonably calculated to reach the entire community. When WMAQ and WSNS have job openings, they also reach a very large potential applicant pool by running on-air announcements about our recruiting web sites at least ten times per week during the day on both stations. Openings are always posted on www.nbcunicareers.com, and the Company's Staffing Center advertises job openings with targeted/specialized web sites in the broadcast industry when necessary. Both stations' web sites also provide links directly to www.nbcunicareers.com. The Company's internal employee web site prominently displays a link to NBCUniversal's Employee Referral Program information. The program is designed to further the promotion of diverse recruiting by our own employees.

Notification to Community Groups and Recruiting Organizations

Since the FCC's new EEO rules went into effect, the stations have developed a list of recruiting organizations, which they believe are suitable for reaching qualified candidates both within and beyond Chicago area. The current list has no specific organizations at this time:

The recruitment print ad for this reporting period was placed in the Chicago Sun-Times and runs on Wednesday, July 18, 2012 and again on Sunday, July 22, 2012.

EMPLOYEE TRAINING

Employees of the Stations are provided with training & development opportunities designed to enhance their ability to assume positions of greater responsibility. Various programs are provided by external vendors and internal GE or NBCU sponsored programs. Station employees participated in the following development courses: T.E.A.M. NBCUniversal; Developing Business Leaders; Leadership Essentials; Technical and Production skills training to include: Chyron, Panasonic broadcast equipment, Dalet News System, Edius Editing System, Sales inventory and commercial traffic application systems; WSI training; PX on-line training.

Sandra Hasan, former VP, Human Resources conducted employee workshops on writing effective performance assessment reviews and managing career growth. Janet Maldonado, HR Generalist has attended training on new NBCUniversal systems for Organizational Management and transaction processing.

The Stations regularly offer training to employees addressing methods of ensuring equal employment opportunities and preventing discrimination. These offerings include Discrimination/Harassment Prevention Training, Integrity Training and Code of Conduct training. Internal employee web site provides specific information regarding the Company's Tuition Reimbursement Program for continuing education, an on-line eLearning catalog of available training courses for employees' personal development.

There is also continual on-line training offered to all employees on the Company's EHS (Environmental Health & Safety) Program s. An in-class training session on First Aid/CPR/AED training was held on October 19, 2011. On May 16, 2012, all News Field Photographers and News production employees and all managers were invited to attend a Civil Disturbance & Riot training course providing awareness on key safety concerns and behaviors relative to working and covering a civil disturbance for News.

Telemundo Network established partnerships with the University of Phoenix and with Nova Southeastern University this past year to offer a discount on tuition for continuing education. The information was distributed to all Chicago employees via email.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

NBCUniversal Chicago, WMAQ-TV & WSNS-TV, maintain an established internship program designed to give exposure to college students about careers in the broadcast industry. During the FCC reporting period covered in this report, 87 college students participated in the program during the last Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer sessions. The NBC/Telemundo Internship Program in Chicago also exposes interns to senior WMAQ and WSNS personnel who address the students and share key career information. Interns participate in the following "Lunch and Learn" sessions during the 2012 summer session: News Management, Creative Services, Sales Leadership, Broadcast Operations & Engineering, Research and Digital/Web Content. The Program Coordinator is Aida Areizaga, Human Resources Coordinator, WMAQ-TV & WSNS-TV, NBCU Chicago.

EMMA BOWEN Foundation for Minority Interests in Media

WMAQ-TV and WSNS-TV, both participate in the Emma Bowen Foundation internship program, a broadcasting industry scholarship program, designed to provide part-time jobs and learning experiences to high school and college students. The program is unlike other intern programs in that the student's work for their partner company during the summers and school breaks from the end of their junior year in high school until they graduate from college. During the five-year-period, students have the opportunity to learn many aspects of corporate operations and develop company specific skills. Students are paid for the work they complete and additionally receive matching dollars from the stations designed to assist them with their academic costs. The Stations have the opportunity to guide and develop minority students to prepare them for opportunities of permanent placement or Associates Program placement upon completion of their college degree. Mentoring from the selected staff in the sponsoring company is also a key element of the program. The stations have had 2 minority students during the period covered by this report.
