## **QUARTERLY ISSUES AND PROGRAM LIST SECOND QUARTER 2023 DUE: JULY 10, 2023**

During the past quarter the issues shown below have been significant to our community. We ran the following programs to address those issues.

ISSUE: Autism

DATE: April 3 and 4

PROGRAM: Focus on the Family

TIME: 12:31 a.m. and 9:31 a.m.

DURATION: 28.5 minutes each program

Jim Daly and his guest Emily Colson talked about the challenges and the joys of raising a child with autism. She explained how she finally came to the realization that her child's special needs could be seen in a positive way. She also described how her son has proven to be a blessing to many people. Emily shared encouragement and help with other parents struggling to raise a special needs child.

ISSUE: Teenage Rebellion

DATE: April 18

PROGRAM: My Family Talk

TIME: 11:31 a.m. and 9:15 p.m.

DURATION: 1.5 minutes each program

Host and teacher Dr. James Dobson talked about the issue of teenage rebellion. He focused on a study done by the National Longitudinal Study of Adolescent Health. The study determined which family factors were most helpful in preventing harmful behavior such as violence or suicide. The study showed that teens were less likely to get into serious trouble when their parents had regular and direct contact with their kids. Dobson encouraged parents to just "be there" for their teenagers.

ISSUE: Honoring Veterans

DATE: May 29

PROGRAM: BreakPoint

TIME: 7:35 a.m.

**DURATION: 4 minutes** 

On this broadcast, host and commentator John Stonestreet played a tribute to veterans from the late Chuck Colson. Colson talked about the enormous sacrifices which were made by the men and women in our Armed Forces. He also explained the great debt of gratitude we owe to them. On this Memorial Day broadcast Colson encouraged each listener to live a good life in gratitude for all those who have sacrificed so much. He also encouraged everyone to thank a veteran for the freedoms that are enjoyed in this country.

PROGRAM: Unshackled

TIME: 10:30 p.m.

**DURATION: 30 minutes** 

In this radio dramatization the true story of Sarah Gonzalez was told. Sarah began abusing drugs and alcohol to cope with the tragic death of her father. The story showed how she overcame her addictions. The program also offered hope to listeners who are dealing with similar situations.

She also offered help and hope to others dealing with this same problem.

Host and teacher Greg Laurie talked about how to deal with difficult people. He showed how forgiveness is a key to maintaining healthy relationships. He also discussed other ways listeners could lead a more peaceful life while interacting with others.

ISSUE: Inflation

DATE: June 19 and 20

PROGRAM: My Money Life

TIME: 2:31 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

DURATION: 2 minutes each program

In a two-part broadcast, host and financial advisor Chuck Bentley talked about some of the causes of inflation, especially those that are dramatically affecting current food prices. He also explained several steps consumers could follow to lower the cost of their groceries.

ISSUE: Strengthening Marriages

PROGRAM: Focus on the Family

TIME: 12:31 a.m. and 9:31 a.m.

DURATION: 28.5 minutes each broadcast

In a two-part broadcast host Jim Daly talked with his guests Milan and Kay Yerkovich. Together they helped listeners to understand how an attachment style impacts the way marriage partners relate to stress. They also described how difficult situations can be used as opportunities to grow closer as a couple. They emphasized how isolation is the worst way to respond to stress and showed couples how to emotionally connect during the hard times in their marriage.
