



## Wisconsin News

### **Tourism spending generates more than \$1 billion**

In 2011, tourists spent nearly \$10 billion in Wisconsin, supporting more than 150,000 jobs and generating over \$1 billion in state-local tax revenues. Tourism's role in the state economy is reviewed in a new report from the Wisconsin Taxpayers Alliance (WISTAX), "Vacationing in Wisconsin." Now celebrating its 80<sup>th</sup> year, WISTAX is a non-profit, nonpartisan organization dedicated to public policy research and citizen education.

According to economic impact reports prepared for the state, tourists spent an estimated \$9.9 billion here in 2011, with the majority spent on lodging (26% of the total), food (25%) and retail (22%). Traveler spending directly or indirectly supported 152,286 jobs and generated \$3.3 billion in tourism labor income. Tourist expenditures were estimated to have generated \$1.3 billion in state-local tax revenues, or about 5% of total taxes and fees collected at the state and local levels in 2011.

As might be expected, tourism's impact varies by county and region. However, WISTAX President Todd A. Berry observed, "What is particularly important about tourism is that, unlike other leading industries, it makes a significant contribution in many parts of the state, both urban and rural."

Particularly in northern counties, the leisure and hospitality industry group, which includes employment in the arts, entertainment, recreation, accommodations and food service industries, is very important. In Florence, Vilas and Bayfield counties, leisure and hospitality accounted for more than 20% of all jobs. Similarly, travel spending as a percentage of personal income illustrates the impact tourism has on northern counties, traveler spending was 8% of personal income or more in Vilas, Oneida, Sawyer, Marinette and Iron counties.

While Wisconsin's tourism industry is important to the state economy, national figures somewhat surprisingly show traveler spending here is below the national average. In 2009, traveler spending here was 23<sup>rd</sup> highest nationally; however, relative to personal income (one measure of the size of the economy), spending here was 40<sup>th</sup> highest, almost 18% below the U.S.

The state helps promote tourism: Wisconsin's tourism budget was \$13.1 million in 2010. Per person, Wisconsin spent \$2.30 in 2010, which exceeded the Midwest average (\$1.87). Among neighbors, only Illinois (\$3.81) spent more per person that year than Wisconsin.


