5:30P NEWS: ACTION NINE: Four days per week, 2:00 in length. Consumer reporter acts as an advocate for consumers who are not getting satisfaction from businesses or government. Tries to help them solve their own problems or encourage the two parties to work out a solution.

ACTION 9 SPECIALS: On Saturday May 4th, 12:30p-1p and Saturday, June 29th, 11:30p-12a WSOC-TV aired special Action 9 reports. Action 9's Jason Stoogenke works hard every day to protect your family and your money- investigating prevalent scams to bad businesses across the Carolinas. Jason walked viewers through his recent investigations informing them what they need to know to protect themselves.

FAMILY FOCUS: One report, two minutes in length, and each week focusing on family and children issues. Reports are part of WSOC-TV's station community campaign: Family Focus, which includes PSA's, events, programs, community projects. Also repeats on Saturday mornings.

TRAFFIC REPORTS: Nine times daily during **EYEWITNESS NEWS DAYBREAK** and once each during 7:25 AM and 8:25 AM breaks. Includes alternate route information. Also, half hour in midday if there is breaking traffic news. Traffic Reports air every 9 mins from 7a-9a on TV64.

WHISTLEBLOWER 9 – A report is done bi-weekly on tax-payer waste.

CLARK HOWARD REPORT – Each Saturday morning a segment is aired and sometimes at noon on the weekends.

CHARLOTTE'S HIDDEN CRISIS: On Wednesday, May 29th from 8p-9p WSOC aired a program that focused on mental health awareness in Charlotte. The special featured local stories on mental health awareness and WSOC-TV had an onsite phone bank manned by mental health professionals for viewers to call from 12p-10p. WSOC-TV also produced a county-by-county resource guide for viewers in the DMA seeking help for mental issues.

9 FOOD DRIVE- June 5th, 2019- Station Collection Day - From children who have no access to lunch programs in the summer, men who are chronically homeless, and women who wouldn't have survived without food donations, **9 Food Drive** exists for the working poor, homeless, and families in poverty.

The 2019 9 Food Drive brought in **101,135 pounds** of food **which will provide 75,000 meals for neighbors in need!**

APRIL 4, 2019 5:00AM**CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL MEETS TO DISCUSS IMMIGRANT MEETINGS**

THIS MORNING, MEMBERS OF CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL'S 'IMMIGRANT COMMUNITY COMMITTEE' WILL MEET TO TALK ABOUT THE PROGRESS THEY'VE MADE SO FAR. THE COMMITTEE FORMED IN FEBRUARY TO ADDRESS IMMIGRANT CONCERNS AFTER A NUMBER OF ICE ARRESTS ACROSS THE CITY. PEOPLE FLOODED CITY COUNCIL DEMANDING MORE BE DONE TO PROTECT IMMIGRANTS. TODAY, LEADERS WILL FOCUS ON THE CHALLENGES THEY STILL FACE AND POLICY SUGGESTIONS THEY'VE RECEIVED FROM PREVIOUS COMMUNITY MEETINGS.

APRIL 16, 2019 6:00AM**DISCUSSION PLANNED FOR POSSIBLE TAX TO FUND ARTS**

TONIGHT, MECKLENBURG COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WILL DISCUSS A POTENTIAL NEW TAX TO FUND ARTS AND CULTURE PROGRAMS. LEADERS ARE TRYING TO DECIDE WHETHER TO INCREASE THE SALES TAX TO PROVIDE A DEDICATED REVENUE STREAM FOR THE ARTS AND SCIENCE COUNCIL. TONIGHT, THE COUNTY MANAGER WILL REVEAL POLLING RESULTS ON HOW THE COMMUNITY FEELS ABOUT IT. COMMISSIONERS CAN DECIDE WHETHER TO PUT THE TAX HIKE ON THE BALLOT.

APRIL 17, 2019 4:30AM**CHARLOTTE LEADERS TRYING TO LOWER NOISE AT ABORTION CLINIC**

TODAY, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL TALK ABOUT WAYS TO REDUCE NOISE OUTSIDE A SOUTHEAST CHARLOTTE ABORTION CLINIC. THEY'RE CONSIDERING AN ORDINANCE THAT WOULD LIMIT THE NUMBER OF PROTESTERS AROUND MEDICAL FACILITIES. CHANNEL 9 HAS REPORTED FOR YEARS ON THE DOZENS OF PROTESTERS WHO REGULARLY SET UP OUTSIDE THE WOMEN'S CLINIC ON LATROBE DRIVE IN SOUTHEAST CHARLOTTE. THE CLINIC HAS TOLD US THOSE PROTESTERS HARASS AND INTIMIDATE WOMEN WHO GO TO THE CLINIC.

APRIL 30, 2019 5:00AM**BIRD E-SCOOTERS LEAVE RALEIGH, ARRIVE IN DURHAM**

BIRD ELECTRIC SCOOTERS ARE PULLING OUT OF RALEIGH THIS WEEK AND ROLLING INTO DURHAM. THE COMPANY BLAMES RALEIGH'S REGULATIONS AND HIGHER FEES TO OPERATE. IN DURHAM, CITY OFFICIALS SAY THEY'LL ALLOW UP TO 200 SCOOTERS FOR EACH COMPANY. LIME WILL ALSO REMOVE THEIR SCOOTERS FROM RALEIGH DURING THE SUMMER. CHARLOTTE PLANNED TO TEST DYNAMIC PRICING, WHICH WOULD IMPACT HOW MUCH LIME AND BIRD ARE CHARGED FOR EACH E-SCOOTER IN THE CITY.

MAY 11, 2019 6:00AM

CITY COUNCIL TO CONSIDER CHANGES AT HISTORIC ESTATE

CHANGES TO THE HISTORIC VAN LANDINGHAM ESTATE IN PLAZA MIDWOOD WILL GO BEFORE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL AGAIN. PLANS HAVE BEEN FILED WITH THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO PRESERVE THE ESTATE AND BUILD TWO NEW BUILDINGS ON THE PROPERTY. CITY COUNCIL WILL HOLD A HEARING AND A VOTE IN THE COMING WEEKS.

MAY 13, 2019 11:00PM

RAIL TRAIL EXPANSION APPROVED

TONIGHT, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL APPROVED THE RAIL TRAIL EXPANSION INTO UPTOWN. THEY PASSED THE \$1.2M CONTRACT TO DESIGN A WALK BRIDGE OVER I-277. THE BRIDGE WOULD CONNECT THE RAIL TRAIL IN SOUTH END TO STONEWALL STATION NEAR THE NEW WHOLE FOODS.

MAY 14, 2019 6:00AM

POLICE CALL ON CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL FOR BETTER PAY

SOME CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG POLICE OFFICERS SAY THEY'RE OVERWORKED AND UNDERSTAFFED, AND IT ONLY HURTS THE PEOPLE THEY SERVE. DURING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET LAST NIGHT, OFFICERS TOLD CITY COUNCIL THE DEPARTMENT IS 200 OFFICERS SHORT, MEANING SOME ARE WORKING A LOT MORE TO FILL THE VOID. BUT MORE WORK DOESN'T NECESSARILY MEAN MORE MONEY. THEY SAY SINCE THEY'RE ON A 28-DAY PAY CYCLE, A LOT OF THEM DON'T GET OVERTIME. AND THEY SAY THAT HURTS EVERYONE. CMPD MADE A PROPOSAL LAST WEEK TO CHANGE THAT 28-DAY PAY CYCLE TO A 14-DAY CYCLE.

MAY 18, 2019 6:00PM

SC LAWMAKERS CONSIDER BILL BANNING ALMOST ALL ABORTIONS

JUST TWO DAYS AFTER ALABAMA PASSED A LAW BANNING ALMOST ALL ABORTIONS IN THE STATE, SOUTH CAROLINA LAWMAKERS SAY THEY'RE READY TO GIVE THE OK IN THE PALMETTO STATE, TOO. GOVERNOR HENRY MCMASTER SAYS HE WILL SIGN A BILL THAT WOULD BAN MOST ABORTIONS. RIGHT NOW, IT'S IN THE STATE SENATE AND COULD BE DEBATED NEXT YEAR. IT WOULD MAKE IT ILLEGAL TO HAVE AN ABORTION ONCE A FETAL HEARTBEAT IS DETECTED. THAT HAPPENS WITHIN FIVE TO SIX WEEKS, BEFORE MANY WOMEN KNOW THEY ARE PREGNANT. MISSOURI JUST PASSED A SIMILAR BILL YESTERDAY. IT BECAME THE LATEST STATE TO PASS STRONGER ANTI-ABORTION LAWS IN THE COUNTRY -- FOLLOWING ALABAMA, MISSISSIPPI, OHIO AND GEORGIA. THESE LAWS COULD PROMPT LEGAL CHALLENGES THAT ULTIMATELY MAKE IT TO THE SUPREME COURT TO REVISIT "ROE V. WADE," WHICH PREVENTS STATES FROM OUTLAWING ABORTION.

CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL LOOKS AT EXPANDING STREETCAR

CHARLOTTE CITY LEADERS COULD SOON APPROVE MILLIONS FOR A FUTURE EXPANSION OF THE STREETCAR LINE. COUNCIL'S BUDGET INCLUDES FUNDS TO HELP PLAN "PHASE THREE" OF THE PROJECT. ONE DAY, THE CITY HOPES TO EXPAND THE LINE TO RUN FROM THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT ON BEATTIES FORD ROAD TO THE OLD EASTLAND MALL SITE IN EAST CHARLOTTE. THE PROJECT IS MANY YEARS AWAY AND FEDERAL FUNDING IS NEEDED.

UPDATE ON CHARLOTTE ROAD SAFETY EXPECTED TONIGHT

TONIGHT, CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL WILL GET AN UPDATE ON A PLAN AIMED TO KEEP PEOPLE SAFE ALONG NEIGHBORHOOD ROADS. LAST YEAR, THE CITY VOTED TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 35 MPH TO 25 MPH. THEY ALSO CHANGED THE POLICY TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR PEOPLE TO REQUEST FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNS AND SPEED BUMPS.

GANDER RV CLOSER TO BEING ABLE TO FLY ITS LARGE FLAG

GANDER RV IS ONE STEP CLOSER TO BEING ABLE TO 'LEGALLY' FLY ITS GIANT AMERICAN FLAG. ACCORDING TO OUR PARTNERS AT THE STATESVILLE RECORD AND LANDMARK, THE STATESVILLE PLANNING BOARD UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED THE CODE CHANGE TO ALLOW FOR GANDER'S 40X80 FOOT FLAG. STATESVILLE HAD BEEN FINING GANDER \$50 A DAY SINCE LAST OCTOBER -- SAYING THE FLAG VIOLATED CITY CODE. THE CITY COUNCIL WILL NOW HAVE TO VOTE ON THE PLANNING BOARD'S RECOMMENDATION.

GOVERNOR COOPER APPROVES ALCOHOL SALES AT COLLEGE GAMES

STARTING THIS FALL, YOU MAY BE ABLE TO BUY BEER AND WINE AT SOME UNC SYSTEM ATHLETIC EVENTS. YESTERDAY, GOVERNOR COOPER SIGNED A BILL INTO LAW, ALLOWING STATE UNIVERSITIES TO SELL ALCOHOL ON GAME DAYS. THE LAW IMMEDIATELY WENT INTO EFFECT, BUT IT'S STILL UP TO EACH SCHOOL'S TRUSTEES TO DECIDE WHETHER TO ALLOW THE SALES.

INVESTIGATORS WARN ABOUT BITCOIN SCAM

MOUNT PLEASANT POLICE ARE WARNING --- A LETTER MULTIPLE PEOPLE HAVE RECEIVED IS A SCAM. POLICE SAY THE SCAMMER IS TRYING TO BLACKMAIL YOU INTO PAYING THEM BITCOIN -- OR THEY'LL REVEAL INFORMATION TO YOUR WIFE AND FRIENDS. THE LETTER EXPLAINS HOW TO USE BITCOIN, WHICH IS A KIND OF DIGITAL CURRENCY. POLICE ADVISE YOU TO IGNORE THE LETTER.

APRIL 9, 2019 5:00AM

POLICE ARREST TWO ACCUSED OF MONUMENT VANDALISM

NEW THIS MORNING, POLICE AT U.N.C. ARRESTED TWO PEOPLE IN CONNECTION WITH VANDALISM OF A CAMPUS MONUMENT. THEY ARRESTED RYAN BARNETT AND NANCY MCCORKLE, WHO THEY SAY ARE CONNECTED TO THE GROUP "HEIRS TO THE CONFEDERACY." THEY BELIEVE THE SUSPECTS SPRAYED RACIAL SLURS ON THE "UNSONG FOUNDERS MEMORIAL" MARCH 31ST. THAT'S A MONUMENT TO AFRICAN-AMERICANS WHO HELPED BUILD THE CAMPUS. POLICE ALSO THINK THE SUSPECTS STOLE A U.N.C. FLAG FROM A SCHOOL OFFICE AND REPLACED IT WITH A CONFEDERATE BATTLE FLAG.

APRIL 22, 2019 11:00PM

SEVERAL HOMES, CARS SHOT AT OVERNIGHT

A 71-YEAR-OLD WOMAN AND ANOTHER MAN ARE IN THE HOSPITAL AFTER SEVERAL HOMES AND CARS IN CHARLOTTE WERE SHOT INTO - ALL IN JUST 15 MINUTES. ALMOST 24 HOURS LATER, CMPD HASN'T MADE ANY ARRESTS. TWO OF THE SHOOTINGS WERE IN NORTH CHARLOTTE - THE OTHER TWO ON THE WEST SIDE. POLICE TOLD US TODAY THEY BELIEVE ALL OF THE INCIDENTS ARE RELATED AND TIED TO AN ONGOING FEUD BETWEEN TWO GROUPS. AT ONE SCENE ON ESMERALDA DRIVE, NEIGHBORS COUNTED MORE THAN 60 SHOTS FIRED.

APRIL 25, 2019 11:00PM

HICKORY POLICE INVESTIGATE SERIES OF ROBBERIES

HICKORY POLICE NEED YOUR HELP FINDING A SUSPECT THEY SAY WAS BEHIND THREE ARMED ROBBERIES SINCE THE BEGINING OF THE MONTH. THESE THREE STORES WERE ROBBED BETWEEN APRIL 2ND AND APRIL 18TH. THEY SAY THIS MAN WOULD ENTER THE STORE, PULL OUT A GUN, THEN DEMAND MONEY BEFORE TAKING OFF. POLICE ARE OFFERING A REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO AN ARREST.

MAY 2, 2019 6:00AM

POLICE ADD REWARD IN CASE OF MURDERED FATHER

A FATHER OF THREE -- WITH ANOTHER CHILD ON THE WAY -- WAS MURDERED. LEADS ARE SLOWING DOWN, SO INVESTIGATORS ARE ADDING A REWARD FOR INFORMATION THAT LEADS TO HIS KILLER. SOMEONE SHOT AND KILLED JAMIE WATTS DURING A HOME INVASION IN POLKTON THREE WEEKS AGO. INVESTIGATORS SAY THERE ARE AT LEAST TWO SUSPECTS, BUT THEY NEED HELP FINDING THEM. CALL POLKTON POLICE IF YOU HAVE ANY INFORMATION.

MAY 9, 2019 11:00PM

POLICE CHASE SUSPECT THROUGH LOS ANGELES

A TERRIFYING CHASE AND SHOOT OUT ON THE STREETS OF LOS ANGELES. A MURDER SUSPECT TRIED TO GET AWAY FROM POLICE AND EVEN FIRED SEVERAL SHOTS OUT OF A CAR WINDOW. THE SITUATION DIDN'T END UNTIL A SHOOTOUT IN A TENSE STANDOFF. POLICE SAY THE SUSPECT IS ACCUSED OF SHOOTING AND KILLING A STORE CLERK DURING A ROBBERY...ALL CAUGHT ON CAMERA. OFFICERS NOTICED THE SUSPECT YESTERDAY AFTERNOON AND STARTED CHASING HIM. YOU CAN SEE HIM FIRING FROM THE PASSENGER WINDOW AS THE CAR SPEEDS DOWN THE ROAD. EVENTUALLY, POLICE SURROUNDED THE DRIVER AND OFFICERS WERE CLOSE ENOUGH TO START FIRING BACK. BOTH THE DRIVER AND SUSPECT WERE HIT. THE WOMAN DRIVING SURRENDERED TO POLICE. THEN A POLICE DOG WAS SENT IN TO GET THE SUSPECT. HE WAS THEN TAKEN TO A HOSPITAL. NO WORD ON THE SUSPECT'S CONDITION AT THE HOSPITAL. A BYSTANDER WAS GRAZED BY A BULLET, BUT THEY'RE OK.

MAY 15, 2019 6:00AM

POLICE RESPOND TO THREAT AGAINST LOCAL SCHOOL

POLICE ARE INCREASING SECURITY IN RESPONSE TO A THREAT CLAIMING THERE WILL BE A SCHOOL SHOOTING AT MOORESVILLE HIGH TOMORROW. THE THREAT ON SOCIAL MEDIA HAS PARENTS UNDERSTANDABLY AFRAID. THE DISTRICT TOLD US THIS THREAT COULD BE REFERRING TO A SCHOOL WITH THE SAME NAME IN INDIANA. AS THEY INVESTIGATE, THEY ARE TAKING THE THREAT SERIOUSLY. ONE STUDENT TOLD CHANNEL NINE HE IS NOT CONCERNED, JUST DISAPPOINTED IN THE PERSON WHO WOULD MAKE THIS THREAT. THE DISTRICT DOES NOT PLAN TO CLOSE THE SCHOOL TOMORROW. POLICE SAY EXTRA OFFICERS WILL BE ON CAMPUS ALL WEEK LONG.

MAY 21, 2019 11:00PM

MATTHEWS POLICE ARREST 14 IN STING OPERATION

FOURTEEN PEOPLE ARE FACING CHARGES FOLLOWING A MONTH-LONG THEFT STING OPERATION IN MATTHEWS. YOU'RE LOOKING AT NINE OF THE PEOPLE POLICE SAY TARGETED A LOWE'S STORE ON MATTHEWS TOWNSHIP PARKWAY. POLICE SAY THEY USED SURVEILLANCE, UNDERCOVER PATROLS, AND CRIME ANALYSIS TO FIND THEM. POLICE SAY SOME OF THEM WORKED TOGETHER, WHILE OTHERS WORKED ALONE. THE OTHER FIVE PEOPLE WERE CHARGED BUT NOT ARRESTED.

JUNE 4, 2019 4:30AM

POLICE INVESTIGATE TWO ROBBERIES 90 MINUTES APART

DETECTIVES ARE INVESTIGATING TWO OVERNIGHT ARMED ROBBERIES IN CHARLOTTE TO SEE IF THEY'RE CONNECTED. THE FIRST HAPPENED AT THIS CIRCLE K ON HARRIS STATION BOULEVARD IN UNIVERSITY CITY JUST BEFORE 1 AM. THE CLERK TOLD POLICE TWO PEOPLE CAME IN WITH A GUN, STOLE MONEY AND LEFT. THE SECOND ROBBERY HAPPENED LESS THAN 90 MINUTES LATER AT THIS SAM'S MART ON NATIONS FORD ROAD IN SOUTHWEST CHARLOTTE. THE CLERK TOLD POLICE 3 SUSPECTS CAME INTO THE STORE WITH A GUN, PISTOL-WHIPPED THEM AND TOOK MONEY. WE'RE ASKING INVESTIGATORS IF EITHER OF THE CRIMES WERE CAUGHT ON SURVEILLANCE VIDEO.

JUNE 11, 2019 11:00PM

SARIAH MCCALL HAD BEEN TEACHING FOR FIVE YEARS IN CHARLESTON COUNTY WHEN SHE DECIDED TO QUIT LAST NOVEMBER. THE WASHINGTON POST PUBLISHED THE LETTER AND SPOKE TO MCCALL ABOUT WHAT LED TO HER DECISION. IN IT, MCCALL OUTLINED LONG, UNPAID WORK HOURS AFTER THE SCHOOL DAY ENDED, UNREALISTIC EXPECTATIONS, AND A LACK OF TIME FOR PLANNING OR BASIC BODILY FUNCTIONS LIKE BATHROOM BREAKS. SHE WROTE, "THE ONLY THINGS KEEPING ME FROM RESIGNING UNTIL NOW WERE THE LOVE I HAVE FOR MY STUDENTS, THE LOVE I HAVE FOR THE ACT OF TEACHING AND THE HEAVY GUILT I FEEL FOR MY CHILDREN BEING NEGATIVELY IMPACTED BY THIS IN ANY WAY, EMOTIONALLY OR ACADEMICALLY. HOWEVER, I CANNOT SET MYSELF ON FIRE TO KEEP SOMEONE ELSE WARM." MCCALL, WHO HAS A MASTER'S DEGREE, NOW LIVES IN SAVANNAH, GEORGIA, WHERE SHE WAITS TABLES. SHE SAYS THE HOURS ARE SHORTER AND THE PAY IS BETTER.

NORTH CAROLINA TO INVESTIGATE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

NORTH CAROLINA SAYS IT WILL INVESTIGATE AFTER A NEW YORK TIMES REPORT ABOUT CHILDREN DYING AFTER HEART SURGERY AT UNC CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL. SOME DOCTORS SAID THEY WOULDN'T FEEL COMFORTABLE EVEN SENDING THEIR OWN CHILDREN TO THE HOSPITAL. EARLIER THIS WEEK, WE TOLD YOU THE PAPER GOT HOLD OF SECRET AUDIO RECORDINGS AT THE CHAPEL HILL HOSPITAL'S PEDIATRIC CARDIOLOGY PROGRAM.
