ISSUE: FAMILY, PARENTING AND RELATIONSHIPS

07/04/2023 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Steve called and said that previously he has heard Dr. Anders say that God does not have a human gender. God is a spiritual being. So Steve asks why does Jesus call God Father? This applies a male gender designation in His teachings and prayers. This gender association for God has persisted over time to this day. Dr. Anders answered by saying, for the same reason that God is described as a mother hen, a bear, an eagle, a mountain, all kinds of metaphors from the natural world of human experience are applied to God. Our God is a consuming fire you find this is sacred scripture. He is called Abba Father. These words mean that God loves us and wants to be a part of our lives.

07/13/2023 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. A caller asked Dr. Anders about the promises associated with the rosary. Dr. Anders answered by saying, if you approach the rosary in a spirit of generosity, genuinely seeking to grow in faith, hope and charity then the meditations of the rosary, the prayers of the rosary can of course be a powerful instrument that moves us to a greater love of God and neighbor and desensitizes us from the practice of sin and vice. He says, so taken in the right spirit, the rosary can certainly do that. Just apply that kind of reasoning to those promises. It is that kind of spirituality that can get you to heaven.

08/04/2023 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders talked about how the church is handling abusive priests. He says we need to be completely honest about the horror shows that have taken place with the abuse of children by Clerics in the Catholic Church and not try to explain it away. In terms of what the church has done, he worked in the administration office of the Catholic Diocese in the office of youth protection. They were very thorough about their investigation.

08/15/2023 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders tells us that today is the 42nd anniversary of the founding of EWTN. Mother Angelica started EWTN in a small garage with only \$200.00. She started broadcasting in 1981 for only four hours a day. She has a famous line that she opened up with, but Dr. Anders couldn't remember it.

09/13/2023 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host is Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders received a call from Karen in Connecticut who is calling for the name of a book to recommend to a Catholic girl who wants to learn more about the Catholic faith. The girl's mother is Jewish and her father is Catholic. Dr. Anders suggested a book

called Catholicism, Journey to the Heart of the Faith whose author is Robert Barons. Also, there is video series on the book as well.

09/20/2023 at 2:00 pm to 2:30pm...Called to Communion...60 minutes...Host Dr. David Anders. Dr. Anders takes a call from Mike in N. Carolina who talks to him about the choir director from his parish who asked him to take a pyx to the Priest and ask for Holy Communion for the people in the choir. He is not an Extraordinary Minister, but still brought the Host's to the choir. He asked if he was wrong in doing this? Dr. Anders said that Extraordinary Ministers are blessed by the church to be able to distribute the Body of Christ. But he doesn't feel any harm was done because Mike had the best of intention.

ISSUE: HEALTH

07/07/2023 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in-show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about researchers reporting the data on the divorce rate. They are saying that parents with big families are less likely to get a divorce. Through a study at Ohio State University data from 57 thousand American's over a forty year period found that families with more siblings were more likely to stay married then where there is only one child. Their conclusion is that bigger families practice good communications, empathy and negotiations. These skills fortify marriages.

07/17/2023 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray started by saying that we label our children with a lot of personality labels. There are parents coming in to his office saying they have an angry eight year old. He asks them, if you gave him everything that he wanted every time he wanted it, would he still be angry? The parents told Dr. Ray, no, he wouldn't be angry. Dr. Ray said this is a kind of temperamental characteristic not anger. You could say the child gets frustrated when he doesn't get his way.

08/8/2023 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is In...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on counseling.

Dr. Ray talked about teenage children who start doubting the Catholic faith because they think that the faith has no reasonable rational evidentiary basis. He tells us that Fr. Spitzer has indisputable scientific evidence for several Eucharistic miracles, the Shroud, the Tilma of Guadalupe, Fatima. He says you could not look at the evidence whatever age you are without seeing that God is revealing Himself to us through scientific evidence. He believes that God is saying, here check this out.

08/21/2023 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked to a caller who asked how a person can change a situation or circumstance that is in our lives that we can't do anything about. Dr Ray says we can only do something about ourselves. We have to figure out how we can change our reaction, think through the situation and that is what you can always do. You may not have any other options.

09/13/2023 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray talked about when people die they have a lot of things to ask God about, their faith and religion. Dr. Ray understands that but also wonders what he would want to know. He says the church teaches that certain conduct is objectively wrong no matter who does it. Only God knows how responsible a person is for their conduct.

09/22/2023 at 1:00 pm...30 minutes...The Doctor is in...Dr. Ray Guarendi, a clinical psychologist, hosted a live call-in show where listeners could ask questions concerning the healthy choices on raising children.

Dr. Ray was talking about social anxiety. People who experience this kind of anxiety worry about other people noticing that they may have looked foolish to them. He says at least this is what is in their own minds. As we age we begin to care less about what other people are thinking. By age sixty we discover they haven't been thinking about us at all.

07/07/2023 at 11:00 am...Women of Grace...Encore...30 minutes...Also 3:00 am...Host is Johnnette Williams.

Johnnette says it's a wonderful thing this gift of intercessory prayer. We need to acknowledge the fact that when we have a relationship with Our Lord Jesus Christ we are trying to live that abundant life in Him and we are striving for that. We recognize and realize that God wants to answer our prayer. He does not want to take Himself away from us. He never abandons us. Through intercessory prayer we are communicating with Him.
