Here is how we addressed it.

Monday through Friday at midnight we air a one hour live national program that Takes phone calls and talks to listeners about staying at home during the virus And it's special challenges.

Monday through Friday at 10:00AM we air "Family Talk" a half hour Daily program that talks about family issues during the virus period. Living together in close quarters, possibly with sickness and out of work Problems are all discussed.

Monday through Friday at 6:00PM we air "Family Life Today" a half hour Daily program that also talks about family issues during the virus period.

Monday through Friday at 6:30PM we air "Focus on the Family" A half hour daily program that continues the conversation about The challenges of successful parenting during the virus period.
