The Lake Area Educational Broadcasting was granted licenses by the Federal Communications Commission for the following stations on these respective dates: KCVO and KCVQ on Jan 21st, 2005; KCVJ and KCVX on Jan 31st, 2005; KCVZ on Feb 4th, 2005; KCVK on April 4th, 2005; KCVY on June 12th, 2006; KCKV on December 23rd, 2009; KVSR on February 18th, 2010; KCKE on February 15th, 2011, and KCKJ on May 2nd, 2012. These license were granted by the FCC to the Lake Area Educational Broadcasting Foundation to serve the public interest as a public trustee until Feb 1st, 2013. These licenses will expire on Feb 1st, 2013. We filed applications for license renewal with the FCC on September 28th, 2012. Copies of these applications are available for inspection during regular business hours at our foundation offices in Camdenton, MO. They contain information concerning the station's performance over the last eight years or for the period of our ownership of these stations.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal applications, and to whether these stations have operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by January 1st, 2013.
