

Upon reading the nomination information we received from their friend, Jeff, we knew we wanted to meet this family. Jeff explained that Sean & Diana Boyll have three children living at home (two teenage daughters and a son in his twenties) and a few years ago, opened their home to Sean's dad as well.

The Boyll girls have had ongoing health issues almost their entire lives and have had many stays in the hospital. So much so that the family adopted the phrase "checking in to Hotel St. Luke's." Their son was accidentally shot about four years ago leaving him paralyzed and requiring a major overhaul of their home to accommodate his wheelchair (among a million other things that would change in their lives coining the family phrase "I guess we didn't think of that"). This included adding a bedroom and bathroom to the downstairs with wheelchair accessible hallways. Along with that was the addition of a ramp in the garage leaving very little room.
